


LOFT CHAIR

DESCRIPTION

Combining the ideas of Scandinavian materiality and industrial design, the Loft Chair features contrasting materials with its frame in powder coated steel that is offset by the warmth of wood with clear or colored PU lacquer.

MATERIAL

Back and seat in veneer with a beech core and an oak veneer top with water-based lacquer. Frame in powder coated steel. For Stained Dark Brown version only: Back and seat with water-based lacquer. Please note that slight color variations can occur due to the inherent characteristics of the material.

CLEANING AND CARE

Wipe off with moist cloth and remove excess liquid with dry cloth.

SPARE PARTS

Pre-mounted plastic glides included. Felt and plastic glides can be purchased seperately.

MADE-TO-ORDER

Option of upholstered seat in all colors from Kvadrat's Remix, Steelcut, Steelcut Trio, Canvas, Clara, Hallingdal, Divina, Divina MD, Divina Melange & Clay (I, 3, 6, 7, 9, IO, I2, I3, I4, I5 & I7) textile series, Ocean (3, 2I, 32, 5O, 52, 8O & 6OI) from Rohleder or leather from premium leather suppliers.
