I am a huge Maxpedition fan. I have been using the same tactical attache case for almost eight years and it still looks brand new. Their compact range bag is proving to be just as durable. This bomb-proof bag is actually two bags in one. The main section of the bag has a removable insert that is customizable via Velcro inserts. This breaks up the removable bag into sections for ammo, glasses, etc. There

are Velcro panels all along the inside of the main bag, allowing for further custom placement of other Velcro-backed pouches, holsters, etc.

The bag has eight zippered storage pockets and six interior pouches suitable for magazines or multi-tools. This bag is the perfect size for an officer going to the range with one or two handguns, eyes, ears and mags. It has ample room for basic cleaning gear. It has a shoulder strap and regular carrying handles as well. I highly recommended the bag for its intended purpose. If you are the type of officer who brings 100 pounds of gear to the range, you will probably want a larger one, but for a trip to the handgun range, this is your bag. //
