Directions for Use

Water Maze CoAg+ Plus should be fed undiluted to a zone of rapid mixing. No prior mixing or activation is required. Feed and storage equipment should be constructed of PVC or FRP. Although Water Maze CoAg+ Plus freezes at <50F, it should be stored at between 50 - 75oF where possible. To ensure maximum activity, this product should be used within twelve months.

Caution

Facilities storing or utilizing chemicals, including this material, should be equipped with an eye-wash facility and a safety shower.
