DRY ERASE CLEAR COAT

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

- Always use a micro-fiber cloth to clean the surface. Avoid using dry erase erasers unless they are clean or replaced regularly.
- Expo brand spray cleaners and wipes can be used to clean writable surface - avoid using glass cleaners like Windex. After using dry erase spray cleaners or wipes, neutralize the surface by periodically wiping with clean water.
- Replace old dry erase markers every year per Expo Markers recommendations or as needed. Old markers have a tendency to stain.
- Wash the Clear Erase surface regularly with a micro-fiber cloth and water. Soapy water can be used, but should be followed with a rinse of straight water to eliminate any residue.

FOR MORE DIFFICULT AREAS

- Quartet brand spray cleaner - The Quartet cleaner is a stronger solution and might work on stubborn stains. Always test an inconspicuous spot before cleaning the entire surface, and wipe clean with water to remove cleaner residue.
- Hand sanitizer - Wipe soiled areas with hand sanitizer. Always test an inconspicuous spot before cleaning the entire surface, and wipe clean with water to remove cleaner residue.
- Denatured Alcohol - Dilute the alcohol with water. Test small areas and mix stronger ratios to clean stubborn stains. **BE SURE TO CLEAN WITH WATER IMMEDIATELY.** Note: Denatured Alcohol has not been tested on Clear Erase dry erase surfaces over a long period of time. Long-term effects are unknown. Use sparingly and first test solution in inconspicuous spots.

A properly cleaned and maintained Clear Erase surface with regular replacement of the dry erase markers should provide years of quality performance.

* Long-term use of traditional and non-traditional dry erase cleaners may have an adverse effect over the life of your dry erase surfaces. We recommend a regular or as needed cleaning of your dry erase surface with water and micro-fiber cloth.
