
Slider Word Drill Lesson 36 br and tr blends


Cut on the dotted lines. On the holder, fold on the gray lines. Cut out the gray windows. Put glue on the flaps with the apples and press onto the back of the front flap. The slide should move freely in the holder. If it is too tight, trim from the top. This will keep the letters on the slide in line with the letters on the holder.

If it is on the list, keep the card and go to any start space. If it is not on the list roll on your next turn to move to different ending blend.

After making a word on the list, begin again on your next turn by drawing a card and rolling.
