
McRuffy Sliders Subtraction

Ten sliding number drills for learning basic subtraction facts 1 to 10



Assembly Directions:

- 1. Cut out slider holder and slider strip: cut on the dashed lines.
- 2. Fold slider: fold on the solid gray lines.
- 3. Make the Answer flap. Cut on the dashed lines from the edge, but not the solid line.
- 4. Cut out the gray windows and gray corner on the slider holder. Cut from the edges of the paper.
- 5. Glue flap c to the back of flap a.
- 6. Cut the two dotted lines on the answer window and fold back flap.
- 7. Insert slider strip into holder. If slider strip is too wide, trim from the top. This will keep the number in-line with the number on the slider.
