


McRuffy Sliders

Subtraction

Ten sliding number drills for learning
basic subtraction facts 1 to 10



Assembly Directions:

1. Cut out slider holder and slider strip: cut on the dashed lines.
2. Fold slider: fold on the solid gray lines.
3. Make the Answer flap. Cut on the dashed lines from the edge, but not the solid line.
4. Cut out the gray windows and gray corner on the slider holder. Cut from the edges of the paper.
5. Glue flap c to the back of flap a.
6. Cut the two dotted lines on the answer window and fold back flap.
7. Insert slider strip into holder. If slider strip is too wide, trim from the top. This will keep the number in-line with the number on the slider.
