His first orchestral work, *The Paper Man*, won the 2017 Young Composers Challenge, and was also premiered by the Akron Symphony in August 2017. In a competition held by Vox Novus, his minute-long piece *Urgency* was chosen for performance by the acclaimed West Point Band. Harrison lives in Little Elm, Texas where he frequently conducts and plays bassoon. When not doing these things, Harrison can be found studying music or simply listening to it.
