Program Notes:

Based on the opening phrase of the Blackburn High School Song – *Ad Lucem Crescimus: Growing Toward the Light,* the phrase also serving as the school's motto, this work takes us on a brief, energetic journey toward the light.

Light can be bright, shaded or dim. The journey we set out on in growing toward the light is not always clearly defined but shrouded by objects seen or unseen. Light can cast shadows or eliminate them. Light can illuminate, make things visible. Growing toward the light can mean a journey to enlightenment, an expansion of understanding, knowing, awareness and insight into ourselves and the world around us. Light can be an end point, something to reach, to achieve. At times we strive toward a goal, sometimes seen, sometimes hidden but we pursue it because it's the thing we seek, the thing we perceive we need. Sometimes we reach the goal only to realise that it is no wast we expected or where we thought we would end up.

Rehearsal Notes:

This work should be approached with an avareness of tempo which should not exceed 120. Clarity of articulation should then be prioritised. In considering the balance of woodwind flourishes with fanface like bass lines, care should be taken to link phrases across instrumentation for standless changes of instrumental colour. Beware of the temptation for a slowing of tempo after [20] and through the Chorale-like section at [34].

About the Composer

Brian Hogg was born in Yorkshire, in the north of England, in 1953; he has been a resident in Australia since migrating with his parents in 1964. After completing a Diploma of Music and working as a musician around Melbourne, Brian returned to study for a Bachelor of Education and began teaching brass and classroom music.

Brian is currently employed by The Salvation Army as a Music Consultant and is responsible for the publication of new music for bands and choirs in the Australian Southern Territory. Brian has long been involved in directing ensembles for The Salvation Army including Melbourne Staff Songsters, Youth Choir and Big Band. As a conductor, the role of music making is important to Brian. Whether working with the adult learners in a band he helped establish in 2007, a State Honours Ensemble, a community group or as a guest conductor for a school, university or conference, Brian strives to extend the musicianship of the ensembles with which he works. His interests in band music developed from his involvement in The Salvation Army in which he continues to play as a member of his local church.
