How to measure your CHILD'S FEET:

- Check that your printer is set to 100% printing scale, otherwise the sizing will not be accurate.
- Print out the sizing chart.

 Tip: Refore measuring check

Tip: Before measuring, check the control box on the printed page to ensure the scale is correct.

- Place the chart on the floor (a hard surface is best), so that the guide line on the chart is against the wall.
- Ask your child to stand on the printed paper. Measure one foot at a time.
- · Check that the foot is on the heel line.
- Ensure the foot and toes are sitting straight on the paper.
- Mark on the paper the point of the longest toe.
- Measure both feet as one foot may be larger than the other. Always choose the largest foot size for purchasing.

BEFORE MEASURING, CHECK THAT THIS BOX IS THE SAME SIZE AS A CREDIT CARD. THIS WILL ENSURE THAT THE SCALE IS CORRECT.
