<b>beg</b>	begin(ning)	<b>skpo</b>	slip one stitch, knit one stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted one, to decrease: see page 118
<b>C6(8:12)B</b>	cable six (eight:twelve) back: see page 119	<b>sk2po</b>	slip one stitch, knit two together, pass slipped stitch over knitted one, to decrease: see page 118
<b>C6F</b>	cable six front: see page 119	<b>sl1(2)</b>	slip one (two) stitch(es), from the left-hand needle to the right-hand needle without knitting it (them)
<b>cm</b>	centimeter(s)	<b>ssk</b>	slip one stitch, slip one stitch, knit slipped stitches together, to decrease: see page 118
<b>cont</b>	continue	<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>g</b>	gram(s)	<b>st st</b>	stockinette (stocking) stitch
<b>in</b>	inch(es)	<b>tbl</b>	through the back loop, knit or purl though the back of the stitch
<b>inc</b>	increase, by working into front and back of next stitch: see page 117	<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>k</b>	knit	<b>WT</b>	with yarn at the back, slip the next stitch purlwise from the left-hand to the right-hand needle. Bring the yarn forward between the needles. Slip the stitch from the right-hand needle back to the left-hand needle. Take the yarn back between the needles. Turn the work.
<b>k2tog</b>	knit two stitches together, to decrease: see page 118	<b>yb</b>	yarn back, between the tips of the needles
<b>kwise</b>	purlwise, slip a stitch as if you were going to knit it	<b>yd</b>	yard(s)
<b>m1</b>	make one stitch, by knitting into the strand between two stitches, to increase: see page 117	<b>yf</b>	yarn forward, between the tips of the needles
<b>m</b>	meter(s)	<b>yo</b>	yarnover, wrap yarn around needle between stitches, to increase and to make an eyelet
<b>mm</b>	millimeter	<b>[ ]</b>	work instructions within square brackets as directed
<b>oz</b>	ounces	<b>*</b>	work instructions after/between asterisk(s) as directed
<b>p</b>	purl		
<b>p2tog</b>	purl two stitches together, to decrease: see page 118		
<b>psso</b>	pass slipped stitch over, pass a slipped stitch over another stitch		
<b>p2sso</b>	pass two slipped stitches over, pass two slipped stitches over another stitch		
<b>pwise</b>	purlwise, slip a stitch as if you were going to purl it		
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)		
<b>rep</b>	repeat		
<b>RS</b>	right side		
<b>RT</b>	right twist: knit into the second stitch from the tip of the left-hand needle, but don't pull the stitch off the needle. Then knit into the first stitch on the left-hand needle and slip both stitches off the needle together.
