

Make your own CORAL DESK-TIDY



You will need:

- Cardboard tubes
- Newspaper
- PVA glue
- Paint
- Carrier bag/egg box
- Cardboard
- Sand (optional)



To make your own coral desk-tidy, first of all, cut the tubes to different heights and arrange on a piece of strong cardboard from an old cardboard box.



Once you are happy with the position of the tubes, glue them onto the cardboard. Glue newspaper all over the cardboard tubes.



When the tubes are completely covered in newspaper, allow to dry.



Next, mix some yellow paint with glue and sand. The sand will give your desk-tidy more texture.



Add some different coloured paint to make your coral reef look more interesting. We've used pink but there are so many colours to be found in a coral reef that you can be as creative as you like!



Once you are happy with your painting, add some colourful plants and weeds using old egg boxes or carrier bags, or any other materials you might find in the recycling bin.
