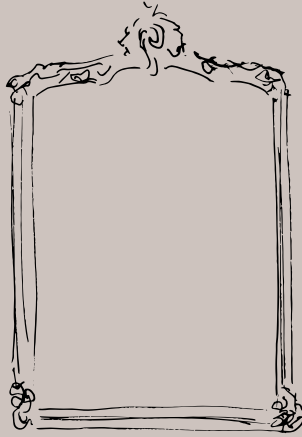

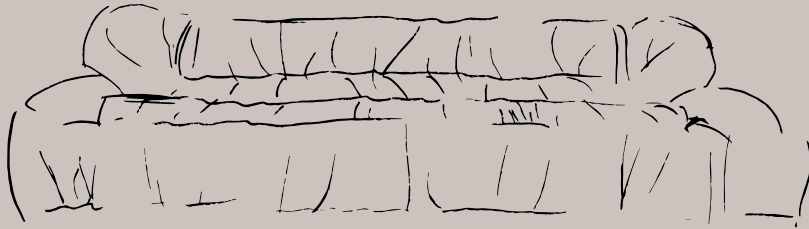

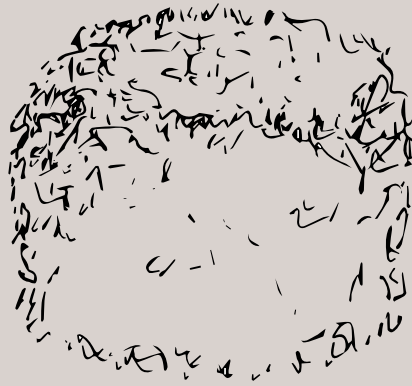
# Lampada Celeste

# Pouff in Lana

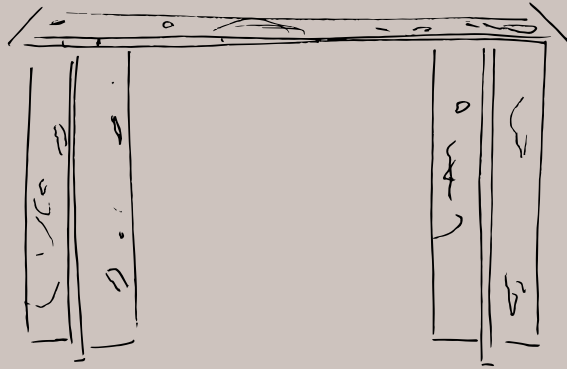

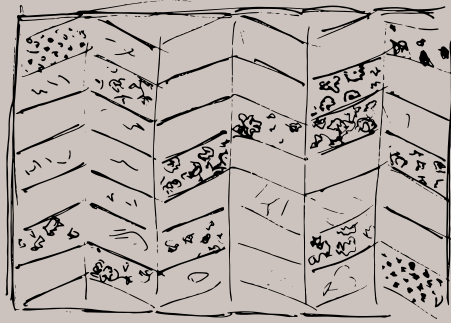
**Natural marble | Each piece is unique in colour**
