

## **Customer Safety Guidelines**

## For the safe use and disposal of felting needles during The Makerss Workshops and Make & Takes

- ! Take great care when using a sharp felting needle.
- ! Don't share needles especially when contaminated.
- ! Dispose of used and broken needles in a safe manner (we have a sharps bin).
- ! Make sure you dispose of all broken parts of the needle. If you cannot find all of it and it may be inside your Feltie you may consider disposing of this too. Hard call, we know! But broken ends will work their way our again if handled and they may cause injury.
- ! Keep needles in a safe place when not in use. For example insert into your felting mat when putting your needle down for a moment.
- ! At home always store your needles in a safe container and keep away from children.
- ! Unless you have the professional equipment to sterilise needles do not attempt to clean them so they can be shared/re-used by somebody else.
- ! Wear shoes at all times when walking across the workshop floor area.
