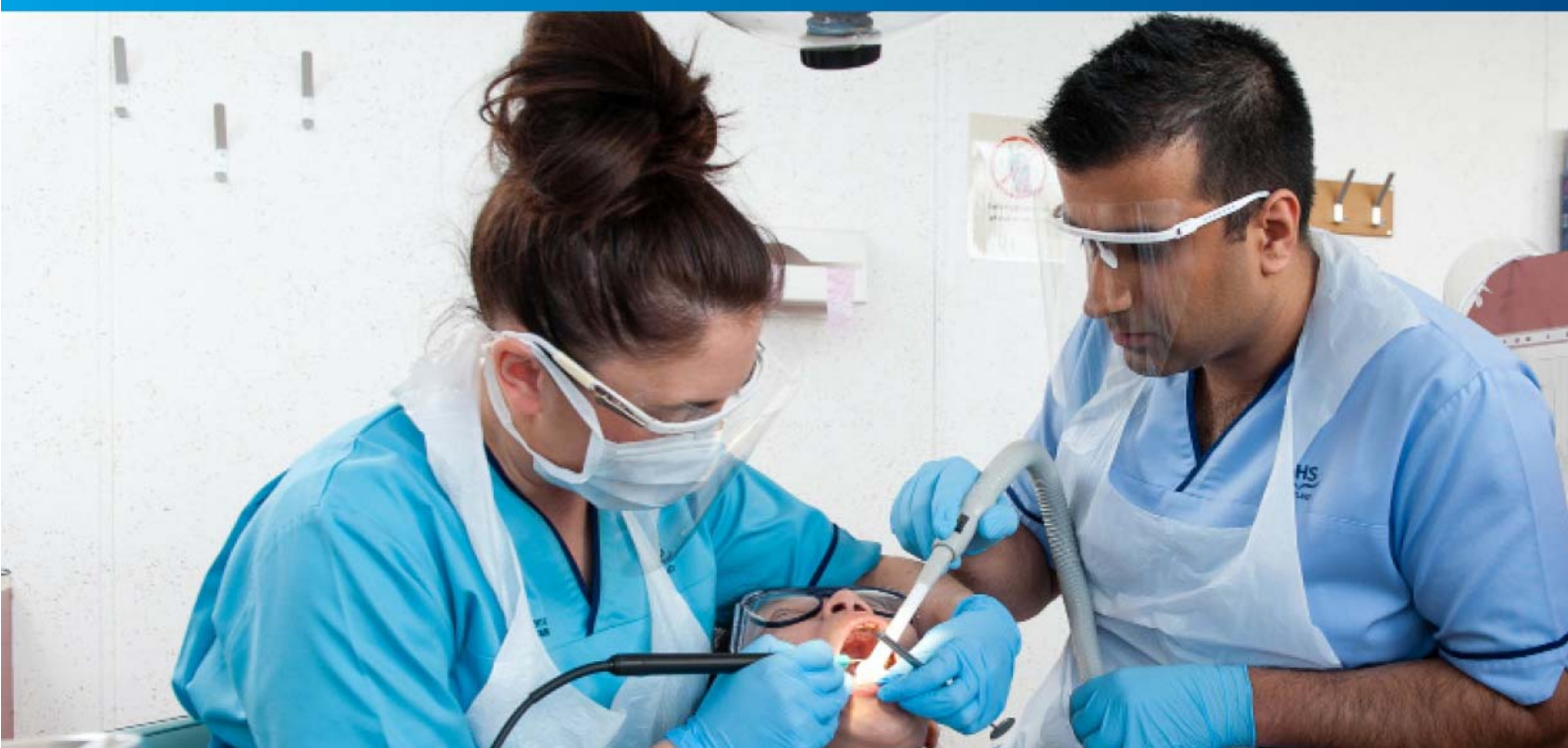

- Do not enter item 27 codes when claiming incomplete dentures.
- You must observe the requirements of narratives and provisos in the Statement of Dental Remuneration for each item.

## Historical Claim and Time-Bar Period
