As part of the **TIDE: Redlands Coast Islands' Festival**, enjoy a full day learning how to create the beautiful **Paper Flowers** embroidery with **Michaela Olsen** at the studio at Colour Streams. You will be using Colour Streams' variegated textiles, threads and ribbons - all natural fibres and all hand-dyed on Macleay Island.

Come alone or with your friends to enjoy this one day workshop on Macleay Island, just off Brisbane within the surrounds of the stunning Moreton Bay Marine Park.

We promise you fun, learning & great company!

Your teacher will be local artist Michaela Olsen. Michaela is a textile designer, artist and has been a teacher of art and design to senior secondary students for over 12 years. She will show you how to create each of the unique stitches you will use to complete this beautiful piece.

The day includes both morning and afternoon tea and lunch (with vegetarian options available).



Each participant receives:

- a 'Paper Flowers' Embroidery Kit (retail value \$105);
- all materials needed to complete your piece including silk ribbons and threads, cotton threads, wool felt, gimp, embroidery needle and embroidery hoop;
- an 18 page colour instruction booklet.

You can choose from two colour-ways - Lillipilli (photo above) or Kookaburra (natural brown and golden tones).
