

Everence Jewelry Care Instructions

Plated Sterling Silver

To care for your rhodium coated sterling silver Everence Jewelry, clean it with a little water, rinse well, and dry thoroughly. Be sure to avoid using any liquid jewelry dips or polishing cloths containing chemicals. Chemicals used on these pieces can cause the plating to wear off more quickly. We suggest gently polishing your items with a clean, dry cloth when needed.

Solid Gold

To care for your solid gold Everence piece please clean with a non-abrasive cleaner. Your piece should ideally be stored in a protective box, case or tarnish-resistant pouch when not in use. Avoid exposing gold jewelry to household bleach. We suggest gently polishing your items with a clean, dry cloth when needed.

Semi-Precious Beaded Bracelets

Like any fine piece of jewelry, beaded bracelets are durable but not indestructible. Since they are made of sterling silver and semi-precious stones, we recommend following standard guidelines for protecting the value of the jewelry: Bracelets must not be worn while showering, swimming, sleeping, or during any activity that might cause the bracelet to become wet, to be pulled, or subjected to pressure. Treat them with the care you would any valuable piece of jewelry.

Is the jewelry waterproof?

All Everence rings and necklaces are waterproof, but Everence bracelets are only water resistant. That means you must not wear your bracelet while in a pool, shower, bath, ocean, or hot tub, or any other water-related activities as this can lead to degradation of the materials. Treat your bracelet with the same care you would any precious bracelet and take it off when you plan to have your hands in water, e.g. washing dishes or washing a car.
