


SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate or install the product. **CAUTION:** Read instructions carefully and turn electricity off at main circuit breaker panel before beginning installation.

CAUTION: Risk of fire. Min. 90°C supply conductors. Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor

WARNING: If any Special Control Devices are used with this Fixture, follow instructions carefully to assure full compliance with N.E.C. requirements. If there are any questions, contact a qualified electrical contractor.

CAUTION: All glass is fragile, use care when handling glass shades and bulbs.

PREPARATION

- 1. Before beginning installation, make sure all parts are included using the contents diagrams from page 1. If any part is missing or damage, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product.
- 2. Estimated assembly time: 30 minutes.
- 3. Tools required for assembly (not included): Phillips screwdriver, pliers, wire stripper, safety glasses, electrical tape, ladder, drill.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Shut off main power supply before cleaning product or changing light bulbs. To clean, wipe with damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaners that contain alcohol.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Screw nipple (AA) and hex nut (DD) onto mounting plate (CC)













2. Use a drill with a #29 (\emptyset .136) (3.5mm) bit to create mounting holes in the junction box.

Next Attach flat washer (FF) and support cable (JJ) onto junction box using screw (EE) to secure tightly.







(JJ) Support Cable



3. Attach assembled parts from step 1 onto junction box, using the mounting screws supplied with the junction box (not included).








ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

4. Assemble nipples (KK) and pipes (HH, JJ) together to achieve a desirable hanging length. NOTE: Also at this time, you may choose to shorten the chain length and electrical/ground wires, but be sure to leave 6" minimum wire lengths beyond the canopy for connection. When completed, pass the wires through the assembled pipe lengths.

Next, attach assembled pipes on fixture using nipple (KK). Secure tightly.

Weave electric cord and ground wire through chain (FF) and chain loop (GG). Open two links of chain and attach both ends to chain loops (GG). Close the chain links. Repeat without wire for other side of fixture to match.

Assembly Instructions

5. Strip $\frac{3}{8}$ " of insulation from the electrical wire ends. Using wire connector (BB), connect RIBBED fixture wire to the WHITE supply wire from the junction box; connect the SMOOTH fixture wire to the BLACK supply wire.


Connect the fixture ground wire and supply ground wire using a wire nut or by fastening to the ground screw on the mounting strap. Push all wire connections into the outlet box.


6. Attach canopy (E) onto nipple (AA) and use finial (GG) to secure the canopy tightly to the ceiling.

7. Screw lamp (not included) into fixture socket. Use 100-watt MAX incandecsent medium base lamp, SBCFL or SBLED.
