### Predator Revisions:

In an effort to keep the Diablosport Predator at the forefront of technology, Diablosport will offer revisions to the Predator when necessary. Updates are available via the web or you can return the Predator for a revision update. Please contact Diablosport for a Return Merchandise Authorization Number (RMA) and an address to ship to. Predators shipped without an RMA number clearly on the outer box will be refused. The updates will be provided free of charge. The customer is responsible for all freight expenses. All DiabloSport products have a guarantee of satisfaction. If in the first 30 days from date of purchase you are not satisfied with the results the Predator generates in your vehicle, simply restore the factory tune to your vehicle and return the Predator to the selling dealer. Pending examination of the tool by DiabloSport, you will receive a refund from your selling dealer. Under no circumstances will DiabloSport accept the return of a Predator unit that does not have a performance tune remaining in it.

Predator Reflash

Policy

The Predator will marry to the vehicle upon upload of the factory tune and cannot be reflashed for any reason, back to a blank tool. This marrying of the Vin# to the tool is what makes it possible for the vehicle to be reflashed by GM,
Y and still be reprogrammed again by the Predator. Reflashing of the Predator is not possible without the complete disassembly, replacement and reprogramming of critical components of the Predator tool.

# OBD II Diagnostic Port Location

Please read through the manual before installing any tune into your vehicle - failure to follow proper instructions can result in a damaged or disabled ECU (Engine Control Unit).

User must ensure that the original Dodge Factory Tune is in the vehicle's ECU before installing the DiabloSport tune. (Dodge dealer reflashes are the same as Factory Tune).

Serious engine damage can occur if the Predator tune is installed over a non-factory/aftermarket performance tune.

## Preparing the vehicle for tune installation

#### Very important! Do not perform any operations on Predator (except live data diagnostics) while vehicle is running. The vehicle must be parked and engine OFF.

- Always have all the doors closed while installing the DiabloSport Performance Tune, and keep them closed until the process is complete.
- Do not activate any electrical accessories while installing the DiabloSport Performance Tune. Ensure that there are no electronic Aftermarket accessories\* wired or plugged into the vehicle that can cause a substantial voltage drop. Please contact DiabloSport if you are uncertain about the effect of devices that are on your vehicle.
- Certain cellular phones or radio equipment might also cause interference. Please remove or turn such devices off.
- Do not try to install any tune on a vehicle with a low battery voltage charge your battery if necessary.
- Unless instructed, never turn the ignition key OFF while the Predator is plugged into diagnostic port.
- Do not unplug the Predator while it is installing the DiabloSport Performance Tune or the Original Backup.

### \*Important Note:

All electronic aftermarket add-on parts can create a potential power draw.

- tachometer electrical fans
- shift light
- audio/video equiptment.
- gauges
- trailer/ tow accessories.

Any change in voltage during flash programming procedures WILL interrupt the writing process.

Please disconnect or disable any such add on part.

In the event of such an occurrence, unplug the tool, wait 5 seconds and then plug it back in. The tool will recognize that a interrupted writing error has occurred and will automatically install the original back up. The vehicle is now in its original state. Please attempt to locate the voltage draw before Predator is used again.

Predator contains several predefined DiabloSport Tunes. These are thoroughly tested and approved by DiabloSport.

Before you install any tune into your vehicle, when you use the Predator for the first time, the Predator becomes 'married' to, and only to, your vehicle until original backup is restored.

If there is ever a need to send the Predator back to DiabloSport, for any reason, the Orginal Backup must be put back into your vehicle, as described in the section Reinstalling the Original Factory Backup', otherwise your Predator will not be accepted back by the reseller. To find out, which tune was last written to your vehicle, go to 'Predator Options / Show Last Tune Written' in the Predator. **DiabloSport Tow**, is designed to add power and torque specifically for towing, weight limitations are the same as stock tune, and inclines must also be factored in.

**DiabloSport Performance** (Economy Performance Tune) is designed to add power and torque, but with fuel economy in mind. Fuel mileage is always subject to driving style and may vary from vehicle to vehicle. towing can be done with this tune with weight limitation of 8,000 lbs. Inclines must also be factored in.

**DiabloSport Extreme** (Extreme Performance Tune) is designed to add power and torque. Towing is NOT recommended with this tune. Exhaust gas temperature gauge is recommended using this tune to ensure safe operation during various conditions.

**DiabloSport Extreme RKL (U7131 only)** (Extreme Performance Tune) is designed to add power and torque. Towing is NOT recommended with this tune. Exhaust gas temperature gauge is recommended using this tune to ensure safe operation during various conditions. Transmission upgrades are highly recommended for this tune as well. **DiabloSport Stacker Tunes**, are designed to be used with the DiabloSport PowerPuck to add power and torque with the ability to switch between 3 power settings on the fly. Leave switch for PowerPuck in the middle position to turn the PowerPuck off, flip the switch towards the notch for the most power and opposite the notch for a medium increase in power.



**DiabloSport Stacker Tow**, is designed to add power and torque specifically for towing, weight limitations are the same as stock tune, and inclines must also be factored in.

# DiabloSport Stacker Performance(U7131 only)

(Economy Performance Tune) is designed to add power and torque, but with fuel economy in mind. Fuel mileage is always subject to driving style and may vary from vehicle to vehicle. towing can be done with this tune with weight limitation of 8,000 lbs. Inclines must also be factored in.

**DiabloSport Stacker Extreme** (Extreme Performance Tune) is designed to add power and torque. Towing is NOT recommended with this tune. Exhaust gas temperature gauge is recommended using this tune to ensure safe operation during various conditions.

# DiabloSport Stacker Extreme RKL (U7131 only)

(Extreme Performance Tune) is designed to add power and torque. Towing is NOT recommended with this tune. Exhaust gas temperature gauge is recommended using this tune to ensure safe operation during various conditions. Transmission upgrades are highly recommended for this tune as well.

# Installing the Performance Tune U7130

The very first time the Predator is used on a vehicle it will automatically create a backup of the original factory tune.

# (Installing the DiabloSport Performance Tune,U7130)

1. Plug the Predator into the Diagnostic Port of the vehicle, located under the driver's side dash.

2. The first screen you will see is the startup screen with the name of the vehicle the predator supports (i.e.:cummins )

3. Performance tune should be three choices:

- Performance Tune
- Diagnostics
- Options
- 4. Select "Performance Tune" by pressing the "Continue" key
- 5. Disclaimer will appear, read & press "Continue"
- 6. Turn engine ON. DO NOT START Vehicle- press "continue"

7. Highlight the tune you would like to install by using arrow keys. Press "enter" to continue

8. Press "enter" on install tune.

9. Follow the prompts to turn on & off the ignition (do not start the car at any time) press "enter" if prompted.

10. The tune should now be writing. Do not interrupt this process or PCM damage can occur.

11. When the Process is complete, the Message "  $\{xxxxx\}$  tune is now in vehicle. You may drive it now. Please unplug the tool"

Unplug the predator from the Diagnostic port. Cycle the key, and start the vehicle. You are now able to enjoy the force of the Predator!!

NOTE: The ABS and Parking Brake lights may stay on for approximately 1-2minutes after vehicle has been programmed, this is normal and will turn off within 1-2 minutes. The very first time the Predator is used on a vehicle it will automatically create a backup of the original factory tune.

### (Installing the DiabloSport Performance Tune,U7131)

1. Plug the Predator into the Diagnostic Port of the vehicle, located under the driver's side dash.

2. The first screen you will see is the startup screen with the name of the vehicle the predator supports (i.e.:cummins )

3. Performance tune should be three choices:

- Performance Tune
- Diagnostics
- Options
- 4. Select "Performance Tune" by pressing the "Continue" key
- 5. Disclaimer will appear, read & press "Continue"
- 6. Turn engine ON. DO NOT START Vehicle- press "continue"
- 7. Select "Tune on the fly". Press "enter" to continue

8 . Select "Install tune", actual tune choices will appear after the initial flash. Allow 10 minutes to program vehicle. Once completed follow the on screen prompts for the key on/off procedures.

NOTE: This is the only time aside from restoring the original backup when engine needs to be turned off and ignition turned on, after this step the engine can stay running while changing the tunes. 8. The initial flash will set STOCK tune as default. Once 10 minute flash is complete and key cycles are complete you will see the main Predator screen.

9. The engine can now be running. Select "Performance Tune", follow on screen prompts and select desired tune, the tunes will install within a few seconds. Once install is complete the Predator will go back to main screen, you can unplug it at anytime after that.

Changing tunes can be done anytime, just plug Predator into OBD-II port and follow the above instructions to select a different tune, once complete it is ok to unplug the Predator.

NOTE: DiabloSport recommends that tune installs and tune changes to be done while vehicle is not moving as it may distract user from driving hazards.

### Tire size adjustment U7131

# Idle up feature U7131

Tire size adjustment:

NOTE: It is recommended to perform this when the vehicle is not moving as it may distract user from driving hazards.

To modify tire size:

1. Select Performance Tune from the main menu and follow on screen prompts.

2. Select Tune on the fly from the tune selection menu and follow on screen prompts.

3. Select desired tune, then select Modify parameters. There will be two options to adjust tire size.

Tire size by sidewall #: When using this selection user must enter the metric sidewall tire size, ex. 245-80-17. NOTE: The default values does not represent your factory tire size.

Tire size by tire height: When using this selection user must measure the physical tire height and enter the height in inches.

Once desired tire size is selected highlight apply and follow on screen prompts.

The tire size change will be applied upon the next key cycle(key on/off).

Idle up feature:

NOTE: The Predator DOES NOT need to be plugged into vehicle for this to work once enabled through modify parameters.

1. With vehicle running and in Park(neutral, park brake on for manual transmissions), press the cruise ON button to enable cruise control, then press SET.

2. Use the accel/decel buttons to increase or decrease idle speed, the ranges are between 1000-1500 rpms.

3. To disable, press the cruise OFF button.

To enable idle up in Predator:

1. Select Performance Tune from the main menu and follow on screen prompts.

2. Select Tune on the fly from the tune selection menu and follow on screen prompts.

3. Select desired tune, then select Modify parameters. Then select idle up. Turn it on to enable and turn off to disable.

NOTE: This feature will only work when you select Modify parameters AFTER the initial 10min flash, once enabled it will stay enabled until disabled or the Original backup is restored.



There are three occasions when one needs to re-install the Original Factory Tune back into the vehicle:

- Going to the dealer for vehicle maintenance or repair.
- Returning the Predator to an Authorized Diablosport Dealer.
- Using the Predator on another vehicle.

To restore Original Backup go to Performance Tune and then select Original Backup.



When the Predator starts to write the Original Backup into your vehicle, a progress bar will indicate the status of writing. Follow all instructions on the Predator screen. The complete process will take about 2 to 4 minutes(U7130), 10 minutes(U7131). Once backup is restored the Predator can be used on another vehicle

## Trial Feature U7131

### Trial feature:

The trial feature will allow user to use an already locked Predator on a friends vehicle to flash a time limited tune of choice. Time limit is 5hours of engine run time. The trial feature can only be used once per vehicle, i.e. User cannot reflash a vehicle which has had the trial feature installed and the trial time has expired.

NOTE: Once the trial tune has expired it is recommended to put the vehicle back to stock using the Original backup option in the Predator, this way there will be no traces of a tune being in the vehicle.

To install trial tune:

1. Select Performance Tune from main menu and follow on screen prompts.

2. Select Tune on the fly, trial from the tune selection menu and follow on screen prompts.

3. Select Install Tune. Actual tune selection will appear after initial flash. Allow 10minutes for the initial flash to complete, ensure to follow on screen prompts for the key on/off procedures. This is the only time aside from restoring the original backup when engine needs to be turned off and ignition turned on, after this step the engine can stay running while changing the tunes.

4. The initial flash of tune on the fly, trial will install STOCK tuning, to change the tune just select desired tune and follow on screen prompts, the tune installs in less than a second.

5. Changing tunes can be done anytime, just plug Predator into OBD\_II port and go to Performance Tune >> Tune on the fly, trial, and select desired tune, once Predator installs the new tune it is ok to unplug it.

NOTE: Whenever using the trial tune the message "This vehicle has trial tune" will come up, this is normal.

Select the "Diagnostics" item from the main menu of the Predator, then press the Enter key.

**Data Logging** 

To start viewing data press the enter button, to pause press enter button.

While paused you can use the left and right arrow keys to move forward or backward in the log file, once desired point is reach press enter key to start displaying values from that specific point. To exit out of the data log press the "ESC" button.

#### **Options Menu**

Display Serial Number = Show the Predators serial number Show Last tune Written = Display the last tune written to vehicle Custom Tune = Custom tune menu, see Custom Tunes section Troubleshooting = See Troubleshooting section Serial Baud = Set the serial baud rate of communications for Predator.

**NOTE:** When switching tool from one vehicle to another vehicle you must go into the options menu and press live table reset.

### Troubleshooting Menu

Show Calibration ID = Display the hex code on the vehicle

Show VIN = Show vehicles VIN number

Read Extra Tune = Reads the tune in the vehicle for export to PC Restore Original Backup = Restores the original tune and resets the tool for use on another vehicle.

Log Upload = Upload data log file to PC, see Diagnostics section.

Live Table Reset = Reset this when  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Predator}}$  is used on a different vehicle.

Verification = This is a troubleshooting feature and should only be used with the supervision of Diablosport tech support.
