Please take a moment to read through the following care and use instructions for your new gloves.

We care a lot about your safety and satisfaction. That's why we've put together a few precautions for you to follow while using your NoCry Gardening Gloves.

- **The NoCry gardening gloves are for minimal risks only. They are puncture-resistant, not puncture-proof. We designed them to offer protection mainly against plant thorns and thistles.** This means they work best when used with caution. We cannot guarantee that they will keep you unharmed in all situations. So, please remain careful while using them.
- **Do not use these gloves for activities involving open flames, sparks or heat.** They aren't heat or flame resistant and could cause you an injury if used for such activities. They are not cut-resistant, so again, do not use them for jobs where a cut or slice could occur.
- **Do not use the gloves when operating power tools.** If a moving part of a power tool touches the glove it can pull the gloved hand towards the machine.
- If possible, **avoid using the gloves when wet.** This can cause them to lose their form and become less comfortable to wear. If the gloves do happen to get wet, hang them to drip dry. Do not use machine drying.
- **The gloves should not be washed and laundered.** Soap and water remove the natural oils present in the leather, causing them to stiffen and become brittle. Use a dry suede brush to remove dust and dirt from your gloves.
