

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE ACCURATELY


For accuracy, please ensure that PDF is printed at 100%, A4 paper size

I. THE PAPER TEST




INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Print and cut out ring sizer above.
- 2. Make a slot in the ring sizer by cutting along dotted line.
- 3. Place ring sizer comfortably around fingers, numbers facing out.
- 4. Secure the ring sizer snuggly around your finger.
- 5. Your approximate ring size should be the number that appears where it says "Ring size".




RING CHART



Ring chart Instructions:

If the finger is not available for measuring, use a ring from the individual's current jewelry collection. Place the ring on a circle within the "ring chart". The correct circle size should fit right against the inside of the ring.

II. THE STRING TEST




Step 1: Cut a slip of paper and wrap around your finger



Step 2: Mark the point where the end of the paper meets.





Step 3: Use ruler to measure the Inside Circumference. Refer to the table below.

| US ring size | 3 | 4 | 5 | 6 | 7 | 8 | 9 |
|---------------------------|-------|-------|-------|-------|-------|-------|-------|
| Diameter of ring (mm) | 14.10 | 14.90 | 15.70 | 16.50 | 17.30 | 18.10 | 18.90 |
| Finger circumference (mm) | 44.0 | 46.5 | 49.0 | 51.5 | 54.0 | 56.6 | 59.1 |
