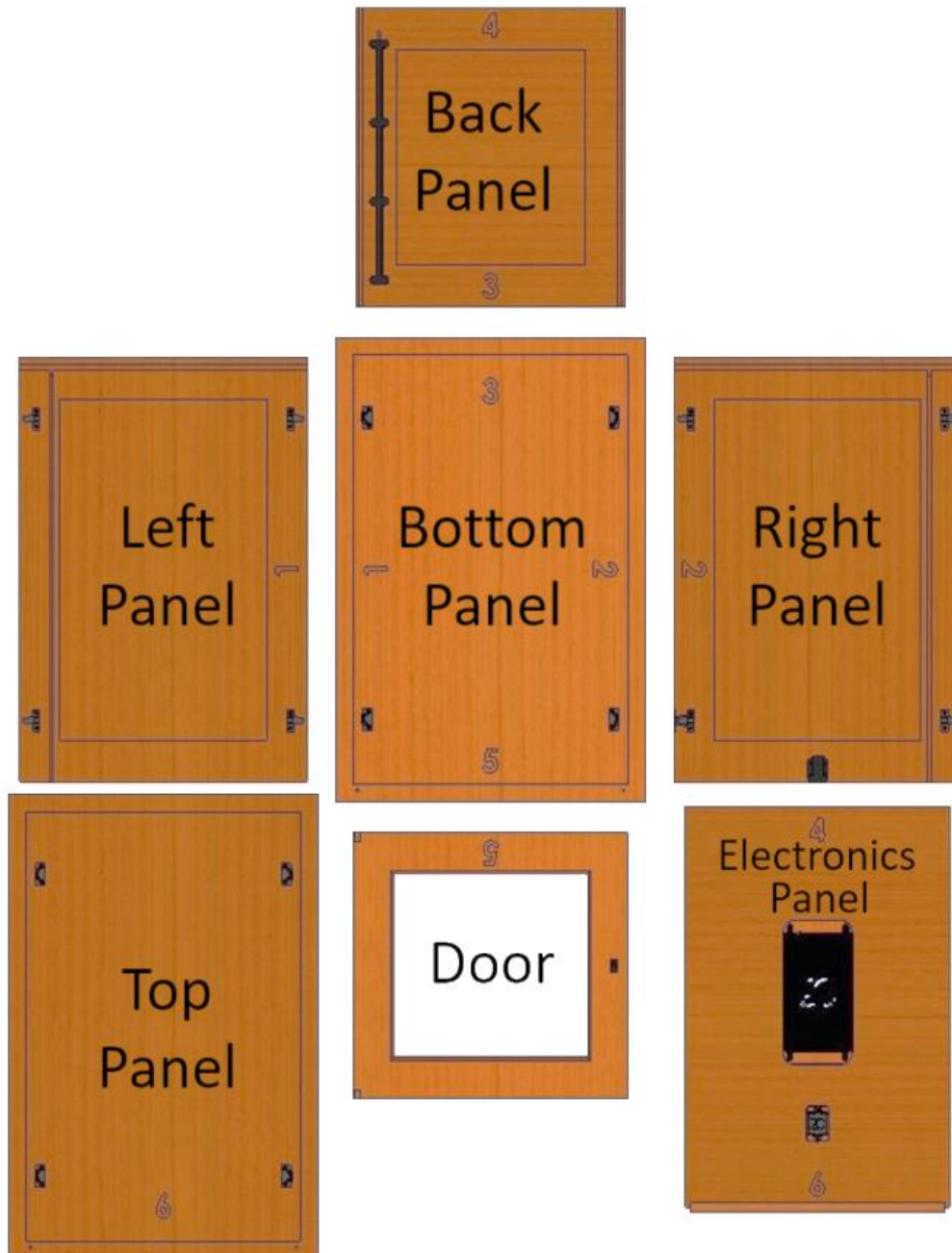


Unpack your ZenCrate

Congratulations! Your dog now owns the most advanced anti-anxiety dog crate! The ZenCrate is super easy to assemble and will take you no more than 5 to 10 minutes to put together.

Package Contents

Your ZenCrate will arrive in 2 separate packages and 3 if you purchased the waterproof memory foam mattress with the following contents: 7 wooden panels (all labeled in *figure 1*), and 1 power supply in a small white box (*figure 1d*). If you ordered the camera add-on it will arrive to you already attached to the electronics panel. If you ordered the memory foam mattress you will have 1 vacuum sealed dog bed (*figure 1a*), 1 waterproof bed liner (*figure 1b*), 1 bed cover (*figure 1c*) Make sure you have plenty of room to assemble your ZenCrate and lay the 7 wooden panels out on the floor, matching up **each number**, as shown in *Figure 1* to ensure you have all the panels.

Assembly – No tools needed

Place all seven (7) panels on the floor as shown in *Figure 1*. We recommend assembling with two people for ease and safety.

Step 1) Left Panel – Align the **number 1** on the left panel with the **number 1** on the bottom panel. With the bottom panel laying on the floor, insert the side panel so the black tabs & numbers line up with each other. Push down firmly until the tabs click into the latches – as shown in *figure 2* below.

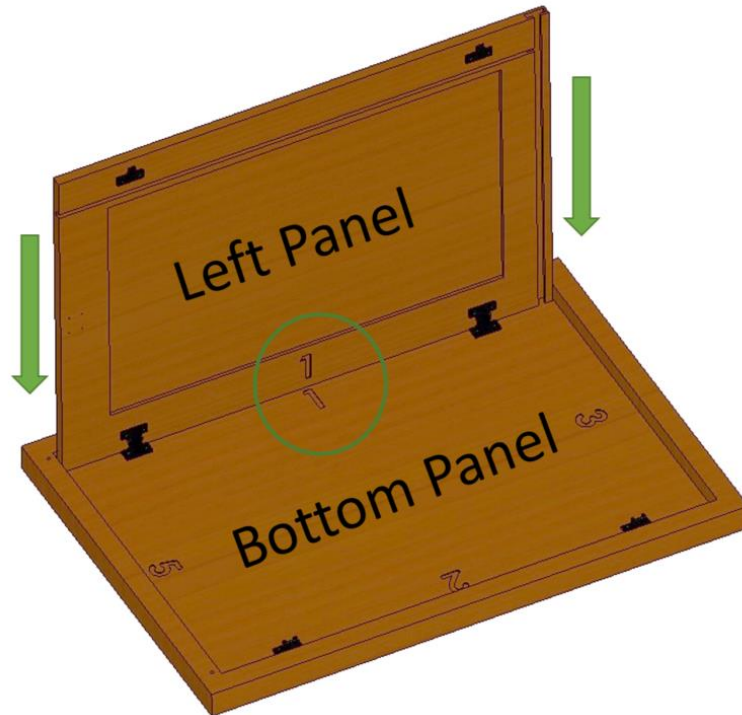

Step 2) Right Panel – Align the **number 2** on the right panel with the **number 2** on the bottom panel. With the bottom panel laying on the floor, insert the side panel so the black tabs & numbers line up with each other.

Push down firmly until the tabs click into the latches – as shown in *figure 3*.

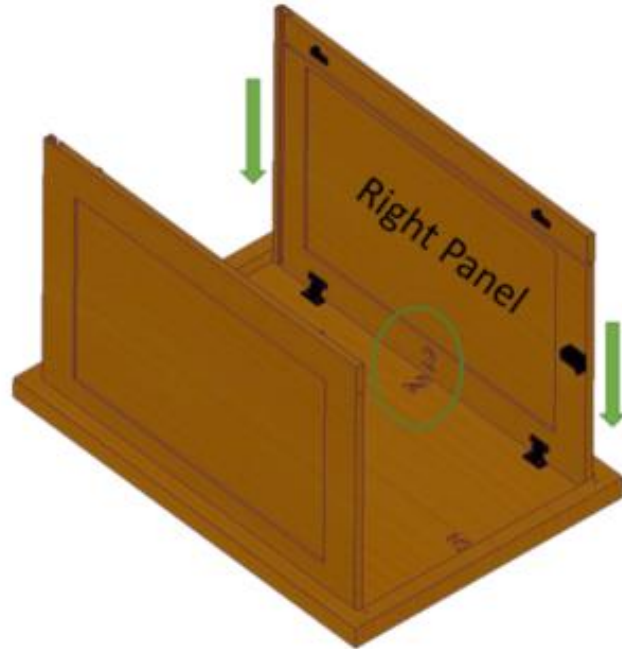

Step 3) Back Panel – Align the **number 3** on the back panel with the **number 3** on the bottom panel. Slide the back panel down along the two grooves of the left and right panels, making sure that the numbers line up – as shown in *figures 4 and 5*. Drape the black cord over the top of the back panel as we will use this cord in **step 4a** – shown in *figure 4*.

Step 4) Electronics Panel – With the plastic “ZC” electronics box facing up, slide it into the grooves of the left & right panels making sure that the **number 4** on the electronics panel lines up with the **number 4** on the back panel – as shown in *figures 6 and 7*. Ensure the electronics cable is draped over the top of the back panel as instructed in **step 3**. Push the panel firmly all the way to the back of the ZenCrate.

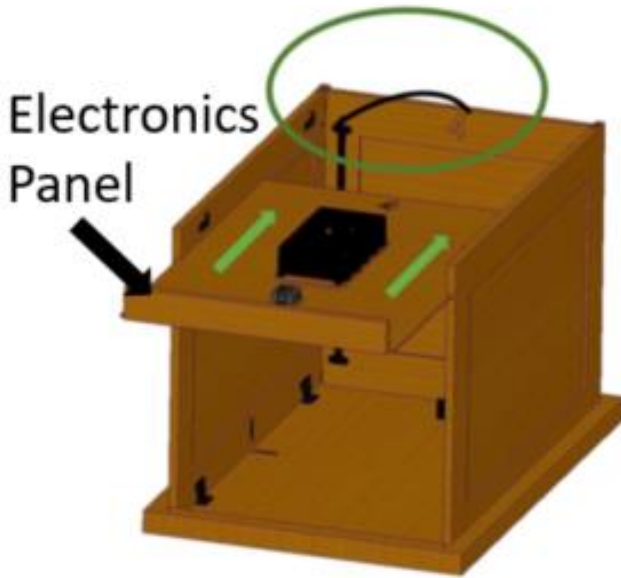

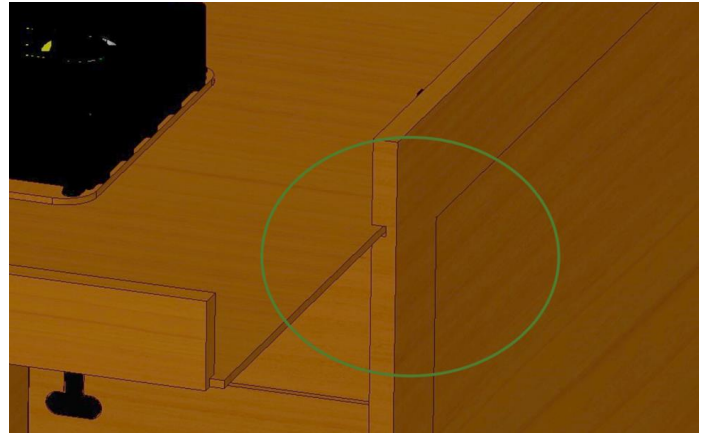

Step 4a) Electronics Cable - Connect the electronics cable that you draped over the back panel to the small power socket on the plastic electronic box – as shown in *figures 8 and 9*.

Step 4b) Optional Camera add on – The camera is the smaller of the two plastic boxes on this panel. Connect the camera to either USB port on the larger plastic box – as shown in *figure 10*.

Step 4c) On/Off (I/O) – Turn the I/O switch to the “I” position – as shown in *figure 11*.

Step 5) Door Panel – Align the **number 5** on the door panel with the **number 5** on the bottom panel – as shown in *figure 12*. The door panel has two metal pins on the top and bottom. Place the bottom pin (this will be on the same side as the **number 5** on the door) into the hole on the left side of the floor panel – as shown in *figure 12*. Let the door rest against the crate momentarily.

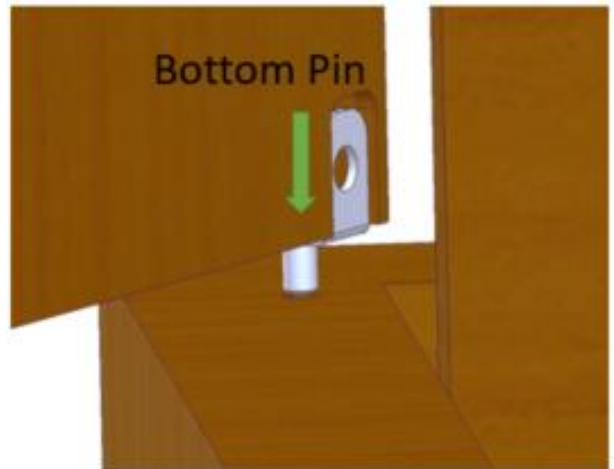

Step 5a) Door Panel latch – Attached to the door there is a small male end that will latch into the female receptacle on the right side panel. The two will need to be lined up together and you can gently push the male end in until it clicks, once clicked in the door will be secure – as shown in *figure 14*.

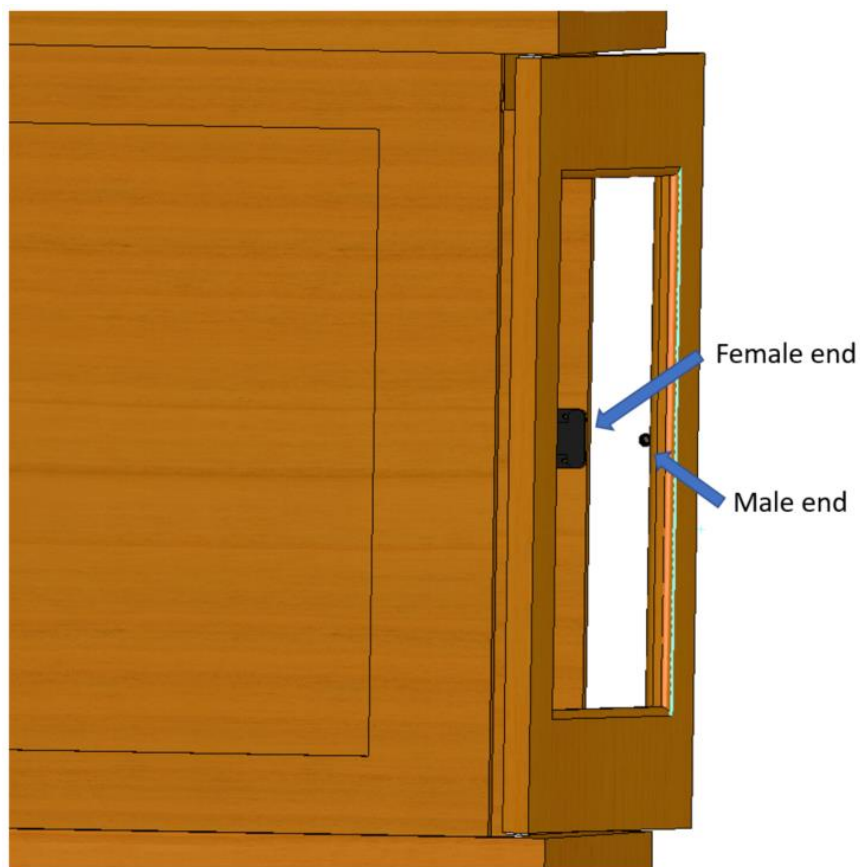

Step 6) Roof Panel – Align the **number 6** on the top panel with the **number 6** on the electronics panel. Then align the four (4) corners of the top panel with the four exposed black tabs on the left and right side panels – as shown in *figure 16*. The top panel will need to be gently pushed downward until the roof panel can also align with the metal pin on the door – shown in *figure 17*. This pin will slide into the small hole on the bottom face of the top panel.

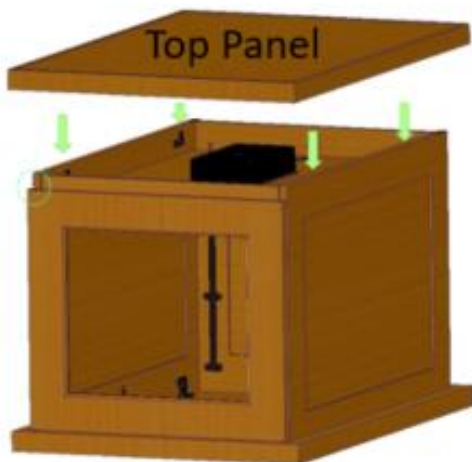

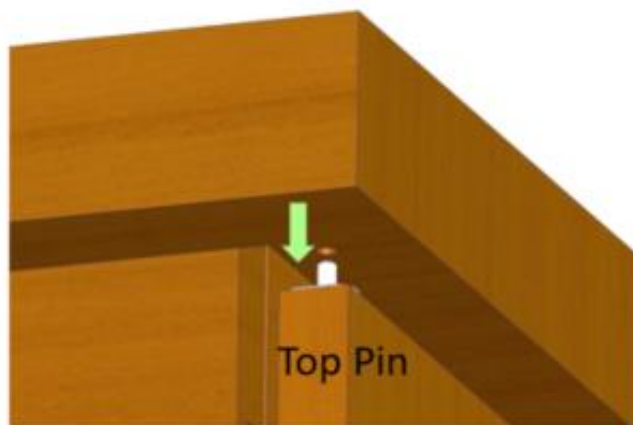

Step 7) Power – Unpack the external power cord from figure 1d. One end of this will plug into a wall outlet and the other end is a circular male end that will plug into the female barrel jack located on the back panel – as shown in *figure 17*.







- a. Go to the App Store and download the “ZenCrate” app. Your device will discover the ZenCrate on the network.


Step	Action	Result
1	<p>Please Note:</p> <p>The ZenCrate app requires iOS 9.1 or later and is compatible with iPhone, iPad and iPod touch.</p> <p>*Please note the ZenCrate will not support WEP Security only WPA/WPA2 and 2.4GHz frequency when connecting to your home router network.</p>	
2	<p>Use your iPhone Settings application to connect to the ‘ZenCrate Setup’ network with password ‘zencrate’. Note the message will show ‘No Internet Connection’ when connected to the ZenCrate Setup network.</p>	

<p>3</p>	<p>Open the ZenCrate app and your device will begin searching for a ZenCrate on the network.</p> <p>*Please Note if the ZenCrate is not found the first time it may have timed out and try discovering again.</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p>Choose your Wi-Fi network and enter your personal Wi-Fi password at this time.</p>	
<p>5</p>	<p>Please wait while the ZenCrate is setting up on the network.</p>	

<p>6</p>	<p>Your device has discovered your ZenCrate and added it to your home network.</p> <p>*If you get an error message or no ZenCrates detected check and make sure your password for your router was entered correct as well as checking your router settings and confirm it is set to WPA/WPA2 security and 2.4GHz frequency. (If you do not know how to log into your router you may need to call your internet provider and they can do it for you. If your system was set to 5.0GHz you can change back after the ZenCrate is connected to your home network)</p>	
<p>7</p>	<p>*Whatever option is greyed out is the selection your device is set to.</p> <p>ON indicates the ZenCrate is on and functioning.</p> <p>OFF Indicates your ZenCrate is off and is NOT functioning.</p> <p>AUTO indicates your ZenCrate will activate whenever your pet enters the ZenCrate.</p> <p>STREAM VIDEO is for purchased optional camera only.</p> <p>SHOW USAGE shows you how often your pet enters the ZenCrate.</p> <p>Volume is adjustable with the slide bar.</p> <p>Note: The Zen Music will stop when your pet exits the ZenCrate when set to AUTO. <p>9</p>	<p>Settings</p> <p>Select 'Disconnect your ZenCrate' to disconnect your ZenCrate from your home network.</p> <p>Any server or firmware updates you need to perform on the crate will show up in this screen and show perform update button above notifications, but you will also get an alert when you first open the ZenCrate App when they are available to you.</p>	






Power Supply: The ZenCrate is equipped with a power supply having a grounding wire with a grounding plug. Make sure you are within close proximity to a power outlet. Do not use outdoors or in damp areas. Do not alter or subject the power supply cord to damage or stress.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS)

Does the ZenCrate come with a door to make the crate enclosed?

The ZenCrate comes with a door with an opening in the front for the dog to come and goes as it pleases. We will be releasing a gate insert as an add-on feature in the near future which will make the ZenCrate a closed crate.

Can I switch the direction of how the door opens?

Yes, we have designed the door to be able to open both ways. If you look closely on your ZenCrate you will notice that we have installed metal holes on both the left and right side of your crate so that you can flip your door around. You will need to use a Philips head screw driver to remove the female latching mechanism from the right side panel and screw it into the left side panel – we have made small pre-drilled holes so you can easily line this up. As always you can contact our customer service support for additional help if needed.

Is the ZenCrate safe?

We use all natural poplar hardwood and plywood, sourced directly from the U.S. that meet or exceed strict regulations, such as the California Air Resources Board or (CARB). Nearly all wood products made overseas or from cheap materials contain formaldehyde, which can be toxic for both humans and animals. Having tight control over these materials is just one reason we have decided to manufacture right here in the U.S.

What are the features of the orthopedic dog bed?

The orthopedic memory foam mattress has a waterproof liner that separates from the mattress for easy cleaning. Both the cover and liner have a zipper on one side. The mattress has 2 inches of full memory foam and 2 inches of support foam. The memory foam waterproof liner and mattress cover can be machine washed in cold water and line dry. Do not place the waterproof liner in the dryer.

Where does ZenCrate ship to?

What is your return policy?

We do not authorize returns based on your dog's usage of the ZenCrate. If a return is granted after contacting a customer service representative shipping will not be covered by ZenCrate for any returns made, this will fall onto the customer.
