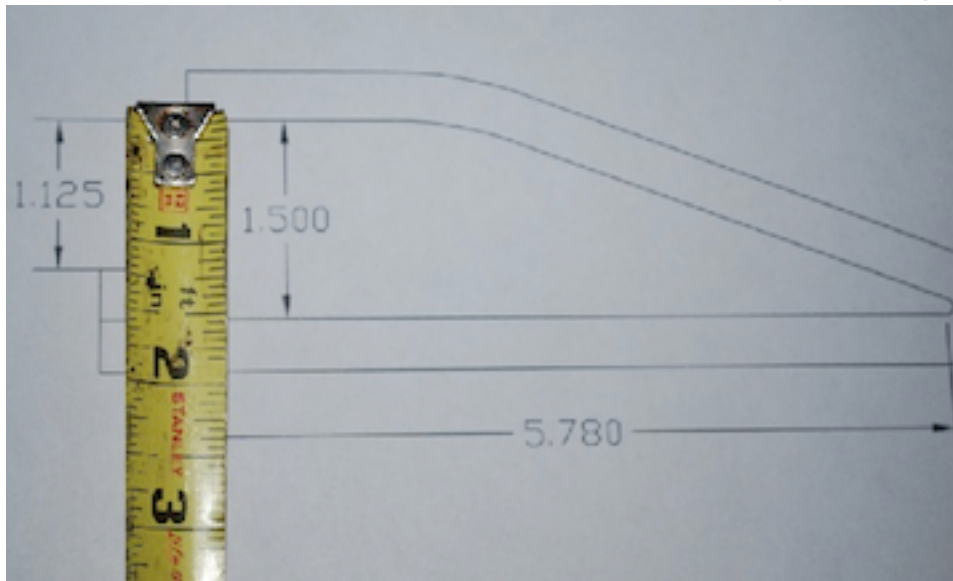


EDGE TAMER

Fitting Template Instructions

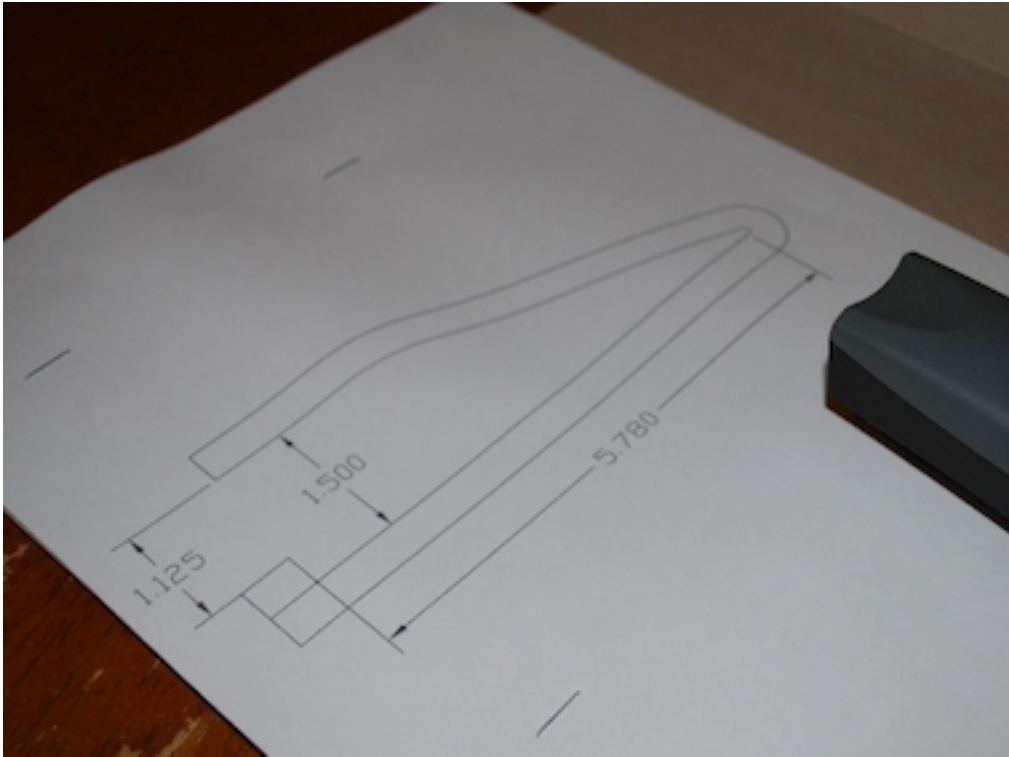
1. Print the template from the website.
2. Verify the printed sheet is properly scaled. A small variance should be fine. If you find it isn't the right fit, one option is to adjust your settings in the pdf print dialog, for example "Actual Size" or "Custom Scale", to get the right sizing.



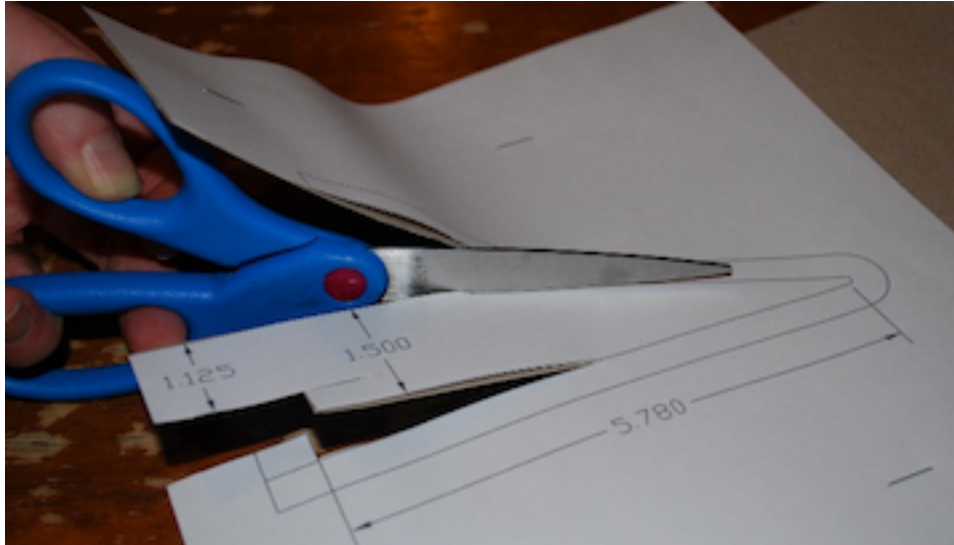
3. **Optional.** Cut out some thin cardboard to be a backing board, to make it easier to function as a template. This is to avoid the annoyance of working with flimsy paper.



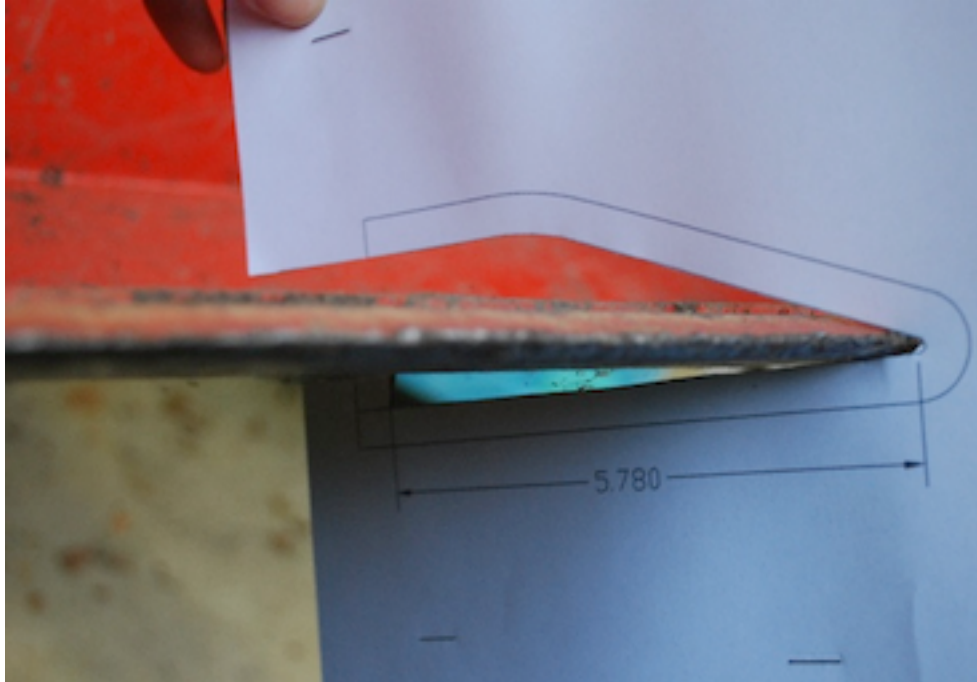
4. **Optional.** Staple or tape the cardboard to the paper. Be sure to leave plenty of surface area near the tip of the “V”.



5. Cut out the inside dimension of the template.



6. Compare it to the leading edge of your bucket. As long as you have space inside, your Edge Tamers should fit.
