## RING SIZE GUIDE

This ring size guide is a guide only.
Where possible it is best to have your ring size measured accurately by Audrey Claude staff during a meeting or at an event. If this is not possible then a high street jeweller will also be able to provide an accurate measure of your ring size.

For best results use a ring with a similar band width to the one you want to purchase.

1. Print out this size guide to $100 \%$ (do not select scale or shrink to fit) and check with a ruler that this line measures 10 cm .

2. Place your ring that fits the finger you want to wear your new ring on over the circles opposite.
3. 
4. Then move your ring to the circle that is the closest match to the INSIDE edge of your existing ring. Try the ring over several circles to ensure you get the best match. You should just barely see the edge of the circle.
5. Your ring siee is the e etere inside that tircle.
