- · Children 16 and under are free when accompanied by a paying adult.
- Drive carefully and watch out for children. Speed limit is 15km/h in camping areas, 10 km/h in the Paddock. Stay ON established roads and OFF the sand hills. Use of off-road vehicles and motorcycles is NOT permitted in the camping areas, but is permitted only in the Paddock and only for race-related business by licensed drivers aged 16 or older.
- · Keep all vehicles off the race track. No Skateboards. No Rollerblading. No Scooters.
- Observe QUIET HOURS from 11:00 pm to 8:00 am. Please turn off all music and generators during this time.
- · Keep your campsite safe and clean. Keep campfires to a reasonable size and place your garbage in the containers provided.
- · For assistance, feel free to stop Security during their drive-bys, or go to any staffed gate.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and you must clean up after them.
- · Do listen to and obey all track Marshals and Security staff. They are there for everyone's well-being and safety.
- For First Aid assistance, please call our Fan Assistance Line at (905) 806-8419. For a serious emergency, please call 911.
- No Fireworks.
- No Glass Containers.
- · No Smoking, No Cannabis Smoking or Vaping in restricted areas.
- · No motorized vehicles of any kind are permitted, including ATVs, golf carts, dirt bikes, scooters, drones, etc.
- · Please show respect and consideration for others at the event.
- Canadian Tire Motorsport Park shall have the right, at any time, and at its sole discretion, to refuse admission to the facilities or to eject from the facilities any
 person for conduct which may be unsafe, discourteous, verbally or physically abusive, influenced by alcohol, drugs or controlled substances, or who we feel may
 threaten or endanger the safety or health of others on the premises, or diminish their enjoyment of the event.
- Children under 16 must at all times be accompanied by an adult while in the Paddocks for their own safety and the safety of others. Children must be kept under adult supervision at all times.
