



2015 FROMM VINTAGE REPORT

This Autumn, Fromm Winery reached a new milestone completed its 25th vintage. While still following the viticulture practices of our European founder, some of the vines are now in their third decade and producing some amazing fruit. The 2015/16 season started off extremely dry following 2014/15, which was the driest season on record for Marlborough and by the end of December 2015 the situation was getting very serious with some of the driest areas only receiving 20 – 25 mm of rain between mid-October and 31st December. Two decent rainfall events in January helped delay water restrictions followed by another in February just in the nick of time. Two more substantial events in late March and early April had no negative impact on the overall quality of the vineyard as we were each time right up to date with our picking. In fact, it gave the late varieties some welcome stimulation. A subsequent period of lovely autumn weather through April helped ensure a large crop was safely harvested. While this excellent growing season has given us some very wines for 2016, we are especially excited about our Syrah and Malbec. In the last 25 years we have rarely seen these two particular wines look so good as they go into barrel at the end of the 2016 harvest.
