Comment This single vineyard wine from Churton's well-established, east-facing hillside vineyard in the Waihopai Valley is a pleasing addition to our single vineyard wine family. It opens with elegant dark red fruits, deep graphite minerality and savoury spice. The palate is honest and charming with a fine texture of integrated tannins and pretty fruit. This is all wrapped in a round, delicious finish.

Short description Dark red fruit (wild strawberries, plums) nuances with aromatic spice and spiced savouriness. The palate is fine with pretty fruit and layered tannins. (January 2018).
