

Comment

The 2001 Rosé was made from Pinot Noir, Merlot and Syrah free-run with minimal skin-contact, resulting in a light, bright coloured wine. Bone-dry with relatively low acidity, this is an excellent food wine, particularly for out-door lunches. It shows the refreshing, delicate flavours of these otherwise substantial red grape varieties with a mouthfilling, firm finish.
