Comment

The 2007 Rosé shows some similarities to the 2005 vintage due to a significant portion of Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Malbec, adding a firm, slightly masculine dimension to this enjoyable summer wine. It is bone-dry, fresh and slightly austere with a herbal element, showing flavours of red berries, pear and ripe apple. This wine goes very well with food and should be served chilled.

Dry Rosé, fresh and slightly austere with flavours of red berries, pear and ripe apple. An excellent food wine for summer. (October 2007)
