The 2009 Rosé is a blend of four red grape varieties, predominantly Merlot and Pinot Noir based, blended with smaller portions of Syrah and Malbec. Delicate floral and red berry aromas are followed by a dry mouth filling palate with fine texture and a persistent lifted finish. A great summer wine, best enjoyed chilled with light food.
