Comment

A charming and alluring Rosé with an air of sophistication. Made predominantly of Pinot Noir lending vibrant notes of watermelon, rockmelon and strawberries n' cream, the balance comprises of Syrah and Malbec offering depth and texture. Unashamedly dry and structured this rosé also shows the bright, freshness inherent to the style with the nose giving an impression of sweetness in the form of pure ripe fruit. The finish is delicate but persistent.
