Comment

A charming and alluring Rosé with an air of sophistication. The Pinot Noir lends vibrant notes of watermelon, rockmelon and strawberries 'n' cream, while the high percentage of Malbec gives the wine an upfront lift of fruit on the nose. The balance of Syrah offers depth and texture. Unashamedly dry and structured, this Rosé shows the bright freshness inherent to the style, with the nose giving an impression of sweetness in the form of pure ripe fruit. The finish is delicate but persistent.
