Comment Pale pink in appearance, this is a charming and elegant Rosé, but is defined more by its structure and texture. We want a Rosé that makes you smile and then makes you think.

With an initial hit of pretty, orange blossom florals this 2017 then reveals vibrant fruit in the form of wild strawberries and cream, watermelon and a suggestion of peaches. The palate is structured and refreshingly bone dry yet the obvious ripe fruit characters leave an impression of inviting sweetness. A delightful Rosé that would match a myriad of different dishes.
