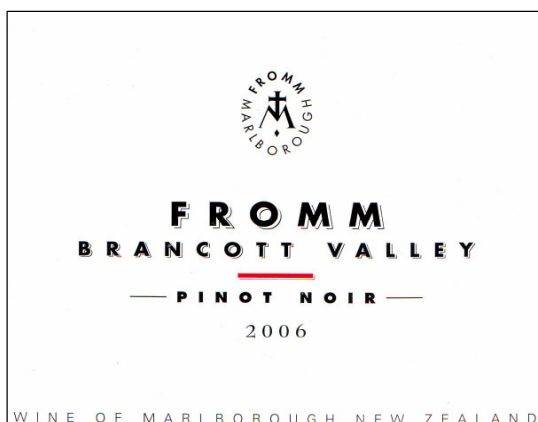

Comment	Dense, vibrant dark red colour; the freshness and intensity carry through on the nose with flavours of red fruit, forest berries and subtle herbal notes. The wine has real presence on the palate, lively with good flow and focus. This is a well proportioned Pinot Noir, harmonious and youthful with a masculine elegance. Very attractive now, although another 6 – 12 months in the bottle will be needed to fully integrate the wine's primary fruit, tannins and underlying savoury/earthy notes.
