**Comment**

2002 looks more and more like an earlier approachable vintage, particularly for Pinot Noir. The Clayvin fruit was very ripe and generous, the structure sound with perhaps a softer structure than expected by "Fromm" standards. Most importantly it remains a true vintage and terroir expression of this exciting vineyard. The wine has a bright dense colour, the nose is rich and complex with nicely integrated dark fruit flavours and some subtle oak in the background. This delicious Pinot Noir should drink beautifully over the next 2-4 years and ideally should be enjoyed before the 2001 vintage.

**Short description**

Forward, medium weight style with early appeal. Ripe, full and complex palate, offering good integration of dark fruit flavours and subtle oak.
