Comment

Brilliant deep red colour, generous and inviting nose of ripe and classic cherry and varietal aromas with a sweet clay and hay terroir note. There are hints of chocolate, mocha, herbal and rose leave flavours. Stylistically this is a New World Pinot with an elusive Old World dimension. It is strong and expressive and already very approachable yet discreetly framed by lots of very fine, subtle tannins. The palate is silky and complex. Still very young and slightly closed at first, the wine opens up beautifully in the glass and will gracefully evolve in the bottle over the next few years.

Short description

Ripe and classic cherry aromas with sweet clay and hay terroir note. Complex and silky with fine, subtle tannins. (December 2005)
