**Comment** Unmistakably Fromm Vineyard, - that first impression of its masculine, tarry nose, followed by a penetrating, slightly austere intensity and dark fruit concentration. The wine has a generous coating of fine-grained, persistent tannins. Discreetly powerful, showing restrained elegance and great cellaring potential. Matured for 17 months in traditional Burgundy Pièces (228 litre barrels) with only 10% new oak. The wine was bottles without filtering or fining and will form a natural sediment in the bottle. We recommend careful decanting.

**Short description** Young and masculine with intense dark fruit concentration. Discreetly powerful with an underlying elegance. Needs 3-5 years cellaring. Decanting recommended. (January 2005)
