Comment

This Syrah is simply delicious. It is soft, rich and generous with an almost Pinot-like velvety texture. A beautifully balanced, multi-layered Syrah, which for the first time contains a symbolic amount of our first Viognier (Viognier is a white variety, traditionally blended with Syrah in many Côte Rôtie wines of the Northern Rhône).

The wine expresses distinct white pepper flavours yet it is very complex and mouthfilling with persistent fine tannin support. Even though it is very enjoyable now, it will comfortably age for 6-10 years. We also recommend enjoying this wine in an appropriate good size glass (e.g. Bordeaux style). As with all wines, using the right glass makes such a difference.

Short description

Delicious, generous Syrah, distinctly varietal, very complex and rich with persistent fine tannins and a gentle, mouthfilling finish. (January 2003)
