Comment

Deep red colour, beautiful dark fruit and white pepper on the nose with an underlying tarryness, very elegant. Not hugely weighty on the palate but a wine with real persistence, finesse and wonderful aromatic flavours reminiscent of Northern Rhône wines. The wine needs at least another year (until 2005) of cellaring. It has a typical cool-climate concentration and firm structure yet shows already an almost sensual touch in its long finish.

Short description

Flavours of dark fruit and white pepper. A beautifully balanced wine, subtle and elegant with fine, ripe tannin support. (January 2004)
