Comment

This wine is made from the same fruit which produced all the Fromm Reserve Syrah's from 1996-1999. In 2000 we de-classified all Syrah (and Merlot) to our standard label in order to preserve the integrity of the Reserve wines. It was a cooler year, providing very intense colour and great flavour concentration but in the case of Syrah without the richness and complexity to elevate the wine to the Reserve standard we established in previous years. The result is a vibrant and very expressive Syrah, medium bodied yet with very deep colour and classic white pepper aromas. Firm and focused in its youth, we expect this wine to benefit over time from the high quality barrel aging it had, gaining warmth and complexity and revealing more of its inherent pedigree.

Short description

Deeply coloured with distinct white pepper aromas. Medium weight, concentrated and expressive. Best from 2003 onwards. (February 2002)
