Comment	This is the first Syrah exclusively made from the Clayvin Vineyard since its replanting in the late nineties. The young vines produced an elegant, ripe style with a subtle aromatic spiciness and a floral lift from the addition of some co-fermented Viognier. The wine's soft, gentle texture has an almost pinot-like charm, reflecting the sensitive vinification of young fruit from this warm clay-terroir.
