
#### **METHOD A:**


MOUNT FROM A POLE LIKE SHEPHERD HOOK

### **METHOD B:**

HANG WITH A USE OF A HOOK FROM A BRANCH TREE, A PORCHE HOOK

### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**





Please know that the squirrel baffle should wobble and not be restrictive when placed onto the collar. This wobble ensures that squirrels and other small animals are unable to climb onto it and access your bird feeder.



# POLE MOUNTING DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Before you begin to install your squirrel baffle, first make sure that you mount the pole you wish to use within an open area of your yard or garden. Also, it's important that the spot you choose to mount the pole is at least 3 5 feet away from any overhanging trees and at least 10 feet away from any structures that squirrels may try to climb such as sheds, decks, and pools.
- 2. Once you've decided on a secure location for your pole, take the squirrel guard's collar and fasten it securely to the pole, making sure that the neck is facing upwards and is at least 4 5 from the ground.
- 3. One the collar is securely fastened to the pole, take the squirrel baffle in your hands and gently twist the open section so that you have a wide enough gap to wrap it around the pole and over the collar.
- 4. Finally, close the squirrel baffle so that the two ends meet and then push the joining tab on the lower underside of the baffle into its slot to ensure that it's secure.

## Collar Mounting Positions for Pole Sizes 1/2-inch to 1-inch diameter






The Ashman Squirrel Proof Baffle has been designed using Galvanized steel that is guaranteed not to rust and cannot be chewed through by squirrels, raccoons, or other animals.

### HANGING BAFFLE INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. To install our squirrel baffle for hanging feeders, start by closing the baffle and securing the joining tab that's on the lower underside of the baffle.
- 2. Once it's securely closed and joined, take 2 of the small nuts and begin threading 1 each into the two eye hooks. Make sure to leave at least 7/16" of the eye hooks' threads exposed for later.
- 3. Afterwards, take the washers and place them onto the threaded portion of each nut. Make sure to hold the washer against the nut before proceeding to push the top eye hook's bolt through the top hole of the squirrel baffle.
- **4.** Next, take a second washer and secure it onto the exposed threaded portion of the nut that is directly below the baffle itself.
- **5.** Once this is done, begin to thread the large coupling nut onto the exposed threaded portion of the bottom eye hook all the way down to where the small nut is.
- **6.** Then begin threading the top eyehook onto into the opposite end of the coupling nut until you feel it contacting the small nut that's threaded onto the top eye hook.
- 7. Next, take a wrench and begin to tighten the 2 small nuts that are on both eye hooks in order to secure them.
- **8.** Now secure a chain or rope to the top eye hook and then attach your bird feeder to the bottom eye hook.
- **9.** When deciding where to place your hanging baffle feeder, take a moment to find a spot where the bird feeder would be hanging at least 5 feet from the ground as well as making sure that it would also be at least 10 feet from any trees, bushes, fences, or buildings.



### **STEPS:**



Unwrap the baffle out of the box.



Unhook the baffle by pushing firmly on the ends.



Push firmly on the ends to unhook the baffle.



Attach the collar to the pole facing neck upwards.



Wrap the baffle around the pole and hook the ends back in the slot.



Place the baffle over the collar.
