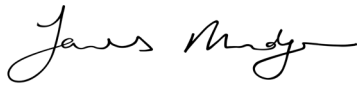

HARVEST BENCH :

Designed to be paired with the Harvest Table, this bench lends itself to a more relaxed dining area. However, it also works well as a standalone piece in a hallway or at the end of a bed.

This bench is available in two timber thicknesses: 44mm and 70mm thick. The 44mm thick bench pairs well with both the 44mm and the 70mm thick tables, but the 70mm thick bench should only be paired with the 70mm thick table design, for the aesthetic proportions.

When bought together with a table, please note that the bench will be 200mm shorter than the table length (100mm on each side) as this works better compositionally. Benches help to maximize seating arrangements, meaning you can get away with a smaller table if needed when paired with benches.

The longest recommended length for the 44mm thick bench is 2800mm, afterwhich, we recommend two benches per side of the table. The 70mm thick bench can be made longer, but bear in mind the ease of use when moving the bench to get in and out as long benches will be heavier.

As a standard, this bench design is made 250mm deep. This offers a narrow bench, which is light and easy to move around, while still offering enough space for comfortable seating. However, we can make this design wider and have reflected a few sizes in our pricing below. The 70mm thick version is made 300mm deep minimum as this looks better proportionally with the thickness of the timber.

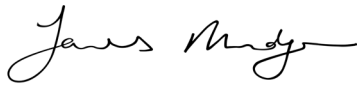
This design is made exclusively from FSC certified timbers (American White Oak, American Ash, American Walnut, French Oak, and Iroko). We seal our furniture with a locally produced, environmentally friendly and non-toxic oil sealant which offers good protection while maintaining a natural aesthetic.

The 70mm thick bench is made from either French Oak or Iroko timbers. Kindly note that French Oak is known for it's character - knots, cracks and discolourations in the timber from part of the natural beauty of this particular wood and are not considered defects. Iroko, on the other hand, has a nutty brown colouring, a straight smooth grain, and very few knots.

The prices below are for Oak, Ash and Iroko only. Please enquire for prices in Walnut. This bench is designed for indoor use only. Please enquire about this design for outdoor use.

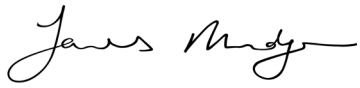

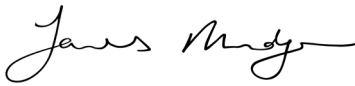

For pairing benches longer than 2800mm with tables we recommend having 2 benches per side. The overall length of the two benches should be between 200 and 300mm shorter than the table length to create an elegant composition.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS - SOLID WOOD INDOOR FURNITURE :

you will need:

soft cloths | rags

water

DAILY CARE :

All the finishes we offer provide good protection to the timber. However, in order to retain the natural finish of the timber we keep the number of protective coats to a minimum. Although this does add to the aesthetic appeal of the product, highlighting the natural qualities of solid wood, it does mean that the finishes are not impervious to damage and staining. However, if you follow the instructions laid out below, it should be sufficient for normal, everyday use.

After use, wipe down the wood surfaces with a slightly damp soft cloth to preserve and protect the wood coating. Dry with another cloth if a lot of water remains. Do not expose these products for any extent of time to pools of water. If the products get wet you should dry them off as soon as possible. Most specifically oil, vinegar and fatty foods should be wiped up immediately using a mild solution of sunlight liquid on a damp cloth. Spills should not be left overnight as they will sink in and mark.

Never use Ammonia (ie Handy Andy) or oil/silicone based cleaners (ie Mr Min) on solid wood furniture as they will damage the finishes and can create cloudy marks.

Placing hot items on the wood may result in damage or burning. We recommend that you use coasters and trivets to protect the table tops from hot dishes.

We do not recommend that you place indoor furniture outdoors for any period of time. Outdoor furniture, even for covered outdoor areas, is specially designed to be able to withstand the dramatic temperature changes and moisture in the air. Exposing indoor furniture to outdoor environments could lead to warping, cracks, discolouration and ultimately will weaken the structural integrity of the design over time. Please enquire about our outdoor range if you are in need of outdoor or semi-outdoor furniture.

When used indoors, avoid placing solidwood furniture in full, everyday sun as exposure to sun/UV can cause yellowing, bleaching and light surface cracks.

Heavily airconditioned environments require the use of an humidifier to restore the natural humidity of the air, as dry air will result in cracking / warping of the timber. This is also the case with central heating in cold climate countries.

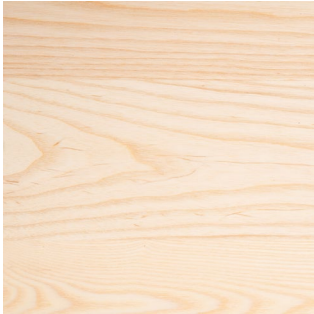
MAINTENANCE :

We work with a local oil manufacturer who produces top quality environmentally friendly and non-toxic oil finishes. When properly taken care of, your indoor piece of furniture should not need much maintenance beyond the above.

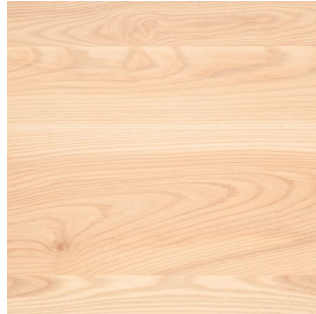

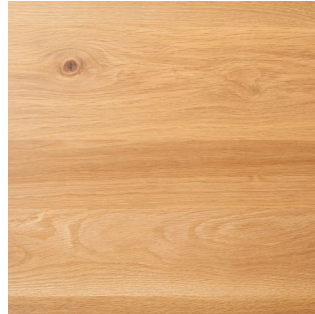
TIMBER SAMPLES - 44MM BENCH :



ash - natural



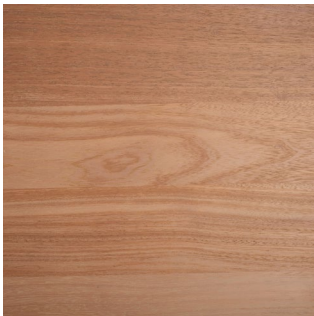
ash - grey oil



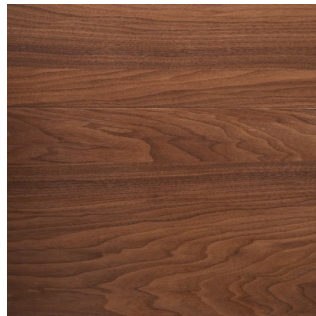
oak - natural



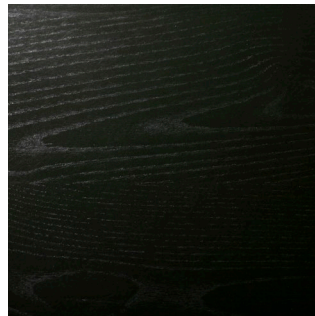
oak - grey oil



iroko - grey oil

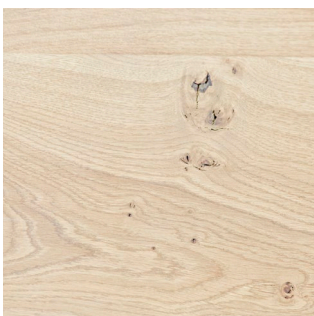


walnut - clear oil

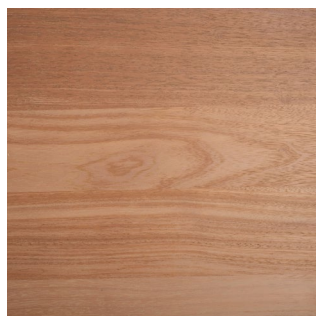


oak - dark charcoal
