#### SPINDLE-BACK CHAIR:

The Spindle-Back Dining Chair is a traditional design, with roots going back as far as 16th century England. Our interpretation shows a minimalist reduction of detail to amplify the fine lines, curves and balance of a well-known and well-loved classic.

The solid timber seat is shaped for maximum comfort and the wide-splayed spindles of the back allow you to really sink into this chair, making it perfect for a leisurely dinner party. In addition to this, the elegant scoop in the timber backrest provides comfort as well as the characteristic attention to detail found in all our pieces, exposing beautiful, traditional finger joint techniques.

This design is available in a number of timbers and finishes. It can also be done in custom colour painted finishes. You can select a colour from either the Plascon, Dulux or Pantone, as long as you provide us with the full colour codes which you will be able to find online. Kindly be advised that, although this specialized finish is hardwearing, the painted finishes will show more wear and tear in the long run as scratches and chips would reveal the natural timber colour underneath.

This design is suitable for indoor use only.

### DAILY CARE:

In order to retain the natural finish of the timber we keep the number of protective coats to a minimum. Although this does add to the aesthetic appeal of the product, highlighting the natural qualities of solid wood, it does mean that the finish is not impervious to damage and staining. However, if you follow the instructions laid out below, it should be sufficient for normal use.

Do not expose these products for any extent of time to pools of water. If the products get wet you should dry them off as soon as possible. Light scuffs can gently be wiped off with a damp cloth and some soapy water.

With the painted and dark charcoal finish, the finish is succeptible to wear. Although the chairs are professionally air gun painted with a durable finish, they will not be impervious to damage and care should be taken when placing and moving chairs around a table etc.

We do not recommend that you place indoor furniture outdoors. Outdoor furniture is specially designed to be able to withstand the dramatic temperature changes and moisture in the air. Avoid placing timber furniture items in full sun as exposure to sun/uV causes yellowing and light surface cracks.

Heavily airconditioned environments require the use of an humidifier to restore the natural humidity of the air, as dry air will result in cracking / warping of the timber.

### MAINTENANCE:

When properly taken care of, your indoor piece of furniture should not need much maintenance beyond the above. All of our indoor tables receive a final coat of clear varnish to increase protection from liquids and foods. As such, you cannot re-oil your indoor furniture without first fully sanding off this layer of varnish.

Should you need to sand and re-oil your piece of furniture please contact us first so that we can recommend the course of action particular to your chosen design, timber and finish.

We work with a local oil manufacturer who produces top quality environmentally friendly and non-toxic oil finishes which we can recommend to you based on your order.
