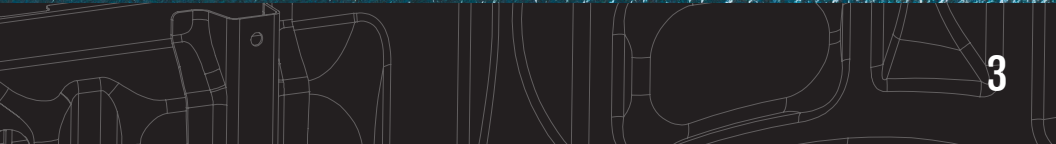


IT'S IN THE NAME

DIAMONDBACK MOLLE PANEL BY BULTRIGHT INSTALLATION

Materials List:

- (1x) MOLLE Panel
- (1x) Allen Wrench - 1/8"
- (4x) Rubber Well Nut - 10-32
- (4x) Steel Mounting Nut - 10-32
- (4x) Screw - 10-32, 1"
- (4x) Screw - 10-32, 3/8"
- (4x) Washer

Suggested Tools:

- Ruler
- Marker
- 3/8" Drill Bit and Drill

Notes:

For ultimate versatility and adjustability, use this MOLLE panel with the DiamondBack ToolBar. If you don't have the ToolBar mounted, skip to part B of this guide on Page 6.

Installing clamps and mounts is possible anytime but is easiest before installing the MOLLE panel. You might consider mocking them up and installing before proceeding!

Procedure Part A: Installing with ToolBar

1. Position the panel where you'd like and slide the included Mounting Nuts into the channel at approximately the correct location as shown in Figure 1. Note that you can choose to mount the panel horizontally or vertically between your ToolBars!

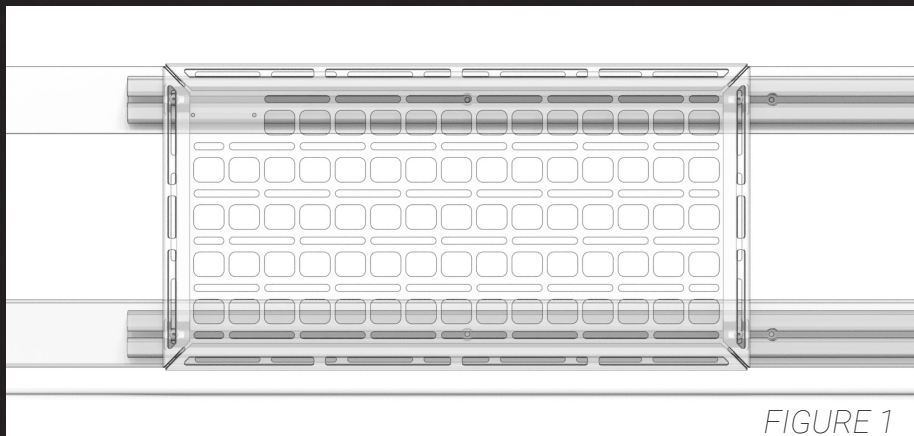

2. Hold the panel in place and install the 3/8in long 10-32 Screws one at a time until all four are loosely installed as shown in Figure 2. You should be able to slide the panel back and forth now.

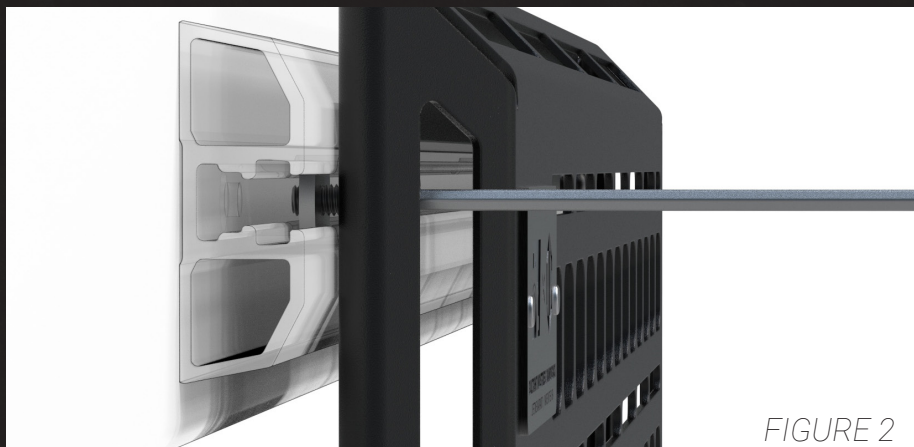

3. Now move the panel into position and complete the installation by tightening down each of the four screws.

Procedure Part B: Installing without ToolBar

1. Begin by opening your DiamondBack cover. If you're able, disconnecting the gas springs from the rear lid and flipping the cover all the way forward/flat will make access easier.

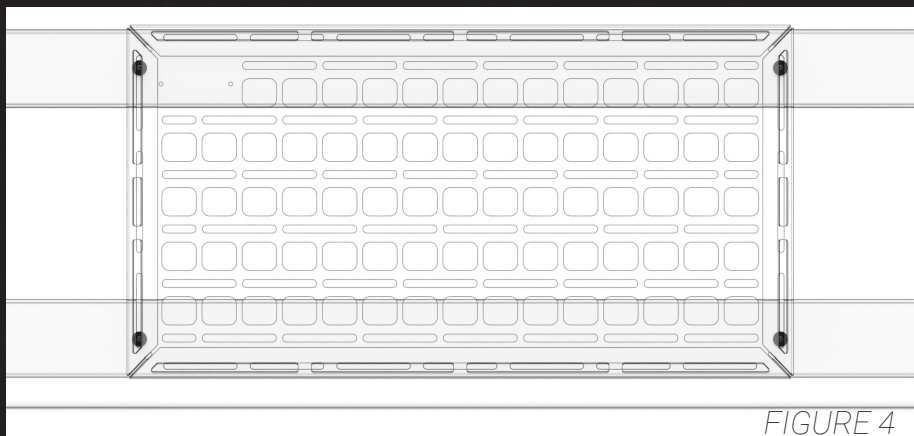

2. Use the MOLLE panel itself as a drill template. Hold the panel in place where you'd like to mount it and mark drill points - approximately one per corner as shown in Figure 4.

3. Double check your marks using the panel and then use your drill and 3/8" bit to drill the four holes. Remove any sharp burrs.

4. Prep the MOLLE panel by putting a longer screw through a washer, through one of the mounting slots and then loosely threading it into one of the Rubber Well Nuts as shown below in Figure 5. Repeat in the other three corners.

5. Carefully lift the panel into place, aligning each of the four Rubber Well Nuts with one of the holes drilled in step 3. Use the included Allen Wrench to begin tightening the four 10-32 Screws as shown in Figure 6.

6. Ensure that the panel is straight and positioned to your liking before completing the installation by tightening the four screws. Skip to Page 6 for some tips and tricks on getting your MOLLE panel setup with gear.

Note: The use of cover-mounted accessories may require stronger gas springs. Contact DiamondBack at 800-935-4002 to purchase.

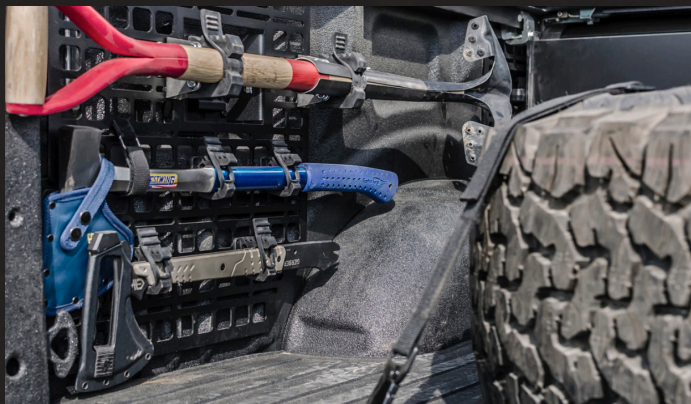
LIFETIME WARRANTY

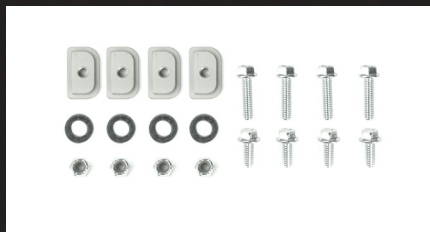
SECURING YOUR GEAR

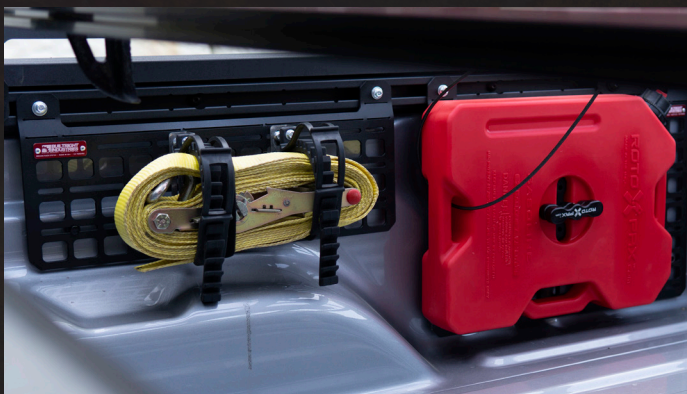


BuiltRight Riser Mounts, Original (104005) are a perfect way to mount shovels, axes and the like.

SECURING YOUR GEAR



Tie down straps, recovery straps, ropes and similar fit well in a pair of the **BuiltRight Riser Mounts, Super Clamp (104011)**. Small fire extinguishers are also a good match for this size.

A 2gal Rotopax Can with mount weighs about 18lbs and can be mounted using our **BuiltRight Rotopax Adapter Plate (104009)**.
