6' Sticker-Tite Rubber Gasket

TOOLS REQUIRED



T30 Torx/Star Wrench



Rubbing Alcohol or Glass Cleaner




Clean, Lint-Free Cloth

INSTRUCTIONS

- To ensure the bulkhead gasket sticks, make sure the surface temperature of your truck is at least 50°F and will remain so for at least a day.
- 50°F min.
- Remove the square-tube top rail of the bulkhead by undoing its five bolts with a T30 Torx wrench.



- Clean the top of the bulkhead thoroughly with a clean, lint-free cloth and rubbing alcohol or glass cleaner. Allow to dry.
- It is very important that the top of the bulkhead be both dry and absolutely free of dirt, oil, or any other contaminants prior to application of the gasket.



- Affix the **gasket** to the top of the bulkhead so that:
 - a. it is tight against the interior edges of the bed rails at both ends, and
 - b. it is flush with the inside edge of the bulkhead.

- 4 Reattach the square-tube top rail to the bulkhead over the gasket.
- Fill the gaps between the bed rail caps and the square-tube top rail with silicone.
- Apply a bead of silicone to the cabward end of each bed rail cap to prevent water from entering the bed from under the cap.
