



TOUGHCOAT RENEW

ToughCoat Renew will dry to renew the look of the spray-on coating on your DiamondBack products. It contains special additives to protect ToughCoat from oxidation and the fading effects of sunshine.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1.** Make sure the ambient temperature is above 50°F. Clean surface thoroughly, removing all dirt, grease, oil, and other residue with similar general purpose citrus cleaner. Use of a high pressure power washer may be necessary in some cases. If coating has been coated with a silicone oil, remove thoroughly or adhesion of ToughCoat Renew may be adversely affected. Allow surface to dry, removing all puddles of standing water.
- 2.** Shake bottle vigorously for 3-4 minutes before applying
- 3.** Apply ToughCoat Renew using a combination of a paint brush and small foam paint roller. Tape off areas that shouldn't receive the treatment. Apply to the sides and edges of the DiamondBack product and around all hardware first, followed by the top surface. Apply as evenly as possible, and avoid leaving puddles or thick areas. Avoid applying in direct sunlight, as the ToughCoat Renew will dry too quickly.
- 4.** Do not apply to painted areas. If this does occur accidentally, wipe immediately with glass cleaner.
- 5.** Use all liquid contents from the bottle for best results. Residual liquid in the bottle may solidify if not used in the initial application.
- 6.** Remove any tape used as soon as possible. During first 2 hours after treatment, avoid touching or allowing dirt, dust, and water to come in contact with the treated surface. Allow ToughCoat Renew to cure for 7 days before hauling on top of your DiamondBack cover.

Use ToughCoat Renew on DiamondBack products sprayed with ToughCoat only. Avoid contact with other surfaces. Exact color match is not guaranteed. Protect from freezing/excessive heat. Store between 50°F and 90°F (10°C - 32°C).
