- Student in Worcester Co. School
- Volunteer experience with OCSC or other local environmental group
Or long term or ongoing environmental projects may be substituted
- Merit based
- High School senior
- Be entering college as full time student in fall of current year
- 3.0 GPA unweighted
- Significant and noteworthy accomplishments as volunteer.

- Proof of acceptance in higher learning institution
- Three (3) letters of recommendations.
 - One from sponsoring faculty member
 - One from community service organization
 - One from faculty member
