



What's My Ring Size?

Not sure what your ring size is? Sense of Style can help you accurately determine the ring size for any finger you want to adorn. There are two simple ways to ensure you get a proper ring size reading: using a ring you already own or our finger measurement tool.

To Measure a Ring You Already Own:

1. Choose a ring in your collection that comfortably fits the intended finger.
2. Find a size circle at the right that matches your ring. The inside edge of the ring, called the diameter, should align with one of the sizing circles.
3. If the ring is between two sizes choose the larger size or try the finger measuring method.

To Measure Your Finger:

1. Carefully cut along the ring sizers outline and make a slit at the dotted line.
2. Now slide the pointed end through the slit with the numbers facing outward.
3. Place the sizer over the intended finger. Make sure to measure the widest part of your finger, even if the widest part is the knuckle, and pull the paper snugly.
4. The number that lines up with the slit corresponds to your ring size for that finger.

TIP: Both heat and cold affect the size of your fingers. For the most accurate measurement, size your finger at the end of the day.

Printing Instructions:

1. Click File, Print or CTRL + P
2. Set Page Scaling to "None."
3. Measure the Sense of Style Ruler at the top of the page to confirm that the markers match correctly.
4. If the measurement is off - even slightly - check the printer settings.
