Results from these studies showed that 93% of the subjects using the HairMax LaserComb experienced hair regrowth. There were no incidences of serious side effect occurrences during the clinical trials, nor has there been any from field use of the device since it was launched in 2001.

An important integral component of the HairMax is the patented teeth mechanism which parts the hair during treatment. Since hair is a natural photo protectant which blocks light energy from reaching the scalp, the teeth mechanism assures maximum delivery of laser light energy to the follicles to achieve optimal results.
